Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Govt. of India is in process of setting up of a Programme Management Unit (PMU) for supporting the activities of developing and mandating Standards for Electronic Goods. The work for developing and mandating standards for electronic goods is in advanced stage and the “Electronics” & IT Goods (Requirement for Compulsory Registration) Order, 2012” has been notified for 30 categories of electronic items.

The PMU is envisaged to work with following objectives:

- To develop/upgrade Indian Standards.
- To mandate technical standards in the interest of public health and safety
- Set up an institutional mechanism within MeitY for mandating compliance to standards for electronics products.
- To develop a National Policy Framework for enforcement and use of Standards and Quality Management Processes.
- Strengthening the lab infrastructure for testing of electronic products and encouraging development of conformity assessment infrastructure by private participation.
- Creating awareness amongst consumers against sub-standard and spurious electronic products.

Terms & Conditions:

1. The candidates selected for engagement will be posted in Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Govt. of India, New Delhi with liability to be assigned duties anywhere in India or abroad.
2. Interested applicants are advised to go through the Eligibility criteria carefully and ascertain themselves regarding their eligibility before registering.
3. Applicants are required to register online from **19/09/2016** to **25/09/2016** through the website **<http://meity.gov.in>**, **<http://nielit.gov.in>** and **<http://nielit.gov.in/delhi>** (under Recruitment section). The dates of interview will be intimated to the candidates through SMS.
4. Retired Government officials having requisite qualifications and experience in relevant domain as mentioned against the post(s) are also eligible to apply.
5. Maximum age limit would be 65 yrs for all candidates for all positions.
6. All the above posts are on contract basis initially for a period of one year extendable up-to project period depending upon the performance and requirement of the organization.
7. In case, contract period is extended beyond one year, the candidate may be entitled for annual increment of 10% after assessment.
8. Selected candidates will not be paid any other financial benefits like Medical, HRA, Transport etc. except the consolidated remuneration.
9. The application fees of Rs. 600/- shall be charged for General/OBC category and Rs.300/- for SC/ST/PWD/Women and Others.
10. No TA/DA will be provided to candidates for appearing for the interview.
11. Final selection of candidates for engagement will be based on the performance of the candidates in the interview and as found eligible as per prescribed criteria. NIELIT reserves

right to conduct written test or skill test for screening the candidate before interview, if felt necessary.

12. Candidates must bring ALL original Mark sheets/ degrees/ testimonials/ post qualification experience certificates (including the Experience letter of the current place of working), Caste/Category Certificate (if applicable) and proof of Date of Birth and their self ATTESTED photocopies on the day of the interview for verification purpose otherwise they will not be allowed to appear the interview. The cut-off date for calculating age and experience will be **01-09-2016**.
13. In case of selection, the engagement shall be subject to verification of original certificates/testimonials at the time of joining and completeness of other formalities otherwise the candidature shall be rejected.
14. Degrees obtained through Open Universities/Distance Education mode that are approved by DEC and wherever necessary, by AICTE, are recognized for the purpose of employment under Central Government vide Gazetted Notification No.44 dated 1st March, 1995.
15. Canvassing/trying to influence NIELIT employees to secure the job in any manner shall disqualify the candidate
16. NIELIT Delhi has the right to accept or reject the application without assigning any reason thereof.
