# MINUTES OF THE 30<sup>th</sup> MEETING OF NATIONAL SKILLS QUALIFICATIONS COMMITTEE (NSQC) HELD ON 23<sup>rd</sup> JUNE 2023

- 1. The **30**<sup>th</sup> **meeting** of the National Skills Qualifications Committee (NSQC) was held on 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2023, through Video conferencing, under the Chairpersonship of Dr. Nirmaljeet Singh Kalsi, Chairperson, National Council of Vocational Education and Training (NCVET). The list of participants is at **Annexure-I.**
- 2. The decisions taken by the Committee, w.r.t agenda items, in the meeting are given in the succeeding paras.

# AGENDA ITEM 01: Confirmation of the Minutes of the 29<sup>th</sup> Meeting of NSQC held on 03<sup>rd</sup> May 2023

- 3. The Committee was given an account of rectification of minor editorial corrections, reported by the stakeholders concerned, in the Minutes of the Meetings of the 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> NSQC.
- 4. The Committee **confirmed the revised minutes** of the 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> meetings of the NSQC. The revised minutes have been uploaded on the website.

The details of corrections are at **Annexure II.** 

# AGENDA ITEM 02: Action Taken Report on the Decisions Taken in the 29<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the NSQC

5. The detailed account of the **action taken** was presented before the Committee on the Minutes of the 29<sup>th</sup> NSQC meeting. The Committee took note of the action taken and **approved** the same.

# AGENDA ITEM 03: Approval of Six Additional New Certificate Templates for Short Term Training (STT)

- 6. The Committee was briefed that the 12 certificate templates catering to various skilling requirements were approved in the 24<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> meetings of the NSQC held on 17.11.22 and 31.1.2023 respectively. However, after receiving requests from the skill ecosystem, certain editorial improvements were felt necessary to make these templates more relevant and appropriate for learners while ensuring smooth implementation. Further, NCVET had also received suggestions from the skilling ecosystem to design six additional templates to cater to specific skilling requirements and to different types of Awarding Bodies. The six (06) certificate templates designed were in respect of the following:
  - a) School Boards
  - b) Standalone National Occupation Standard (NOS)
  - c) Micro Credentials
  - d) Recognition of Prior Learning with Upskilling

d) Recognition of

- e) Reskilling
- f) Upskilling
- 7. The Committee approved the necessary editorial improvements carried out in the existing certificate templates. The Committee also approved the six new certificate templates. The approved Certificate templates designs are at **Annexure III.**

AGENDA ITEM 04: Ratification of Qualifications from two Recognized ABs: Water Management and Plumbing Skill Council (WMPSC) and Food Industry Capacity & Skill Initiative (FICSI)

- 8. Water Management and Plumbing Skill Council (WMPSC)
  - 8.1. The Committee was apprised that in a joint meeting held with the Secretaries of Ministry of Jal Shakti and MSDE for developing a multi-skilling qualification/job role to provide skilled manpower to Village Water and Sanitary Committees (VWSCs) of Panchayats under the flagship scheme of Jal-Jeevan Mission (JJM) of Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation (DDWS) on 23.05.2023.
  - 8.2. Accordingly, WMPSC has developed the qualification "जल वितरण संचालक (Water Distribution System Operator) (Multi-Skill)" and submitted to NCVET along with a request from Ministry of Jal Shakti for approval of the qualification at the earliest to enable early rollout of the training programs on the qualification.
  - 8.3. After reviewing the parameters of the qualification in accordance with the NSQF norms, and considering the urgency, the Qualification was **approved 'on file' on** 13/06/2023.
  - 8.4. The committee took note of the same and ratified the qualification "जल वितरण संचालक (Water Distribution System Operator) (Multi-Skill)". The details of the qualification are given in Annexure V.

### 9. Food Industry Capacity & Skill Initiative (FICSI)

- 9.1. The Committee was apprised that United Nations General Assembly (UNGA), has declared the year **2023 as International Year of Millets (IYM)**. UNDP had therefore proposed the FICSI to develop, train, assess, and certify trainers on millet food product manufacturing in Jharkhand. Accordingly, FICSI developed a qualification on "Millet Products Processor" for NSQF alignment and approval. Keeping in view the urgency, the Qualification was approved 'on file' on 13/06/2023.
- 9.2. The committee took note of the same and ratified the qualification "Millet

**Products Processor**". The details of the qualification are in **Annexure V**.

### AGENDA ITEM 05: Request for Modification in the Defence Qualification-'Commercial Vehicle Driver (Heavy Motor Vehicle) by Directorate General of Armoured Corps Approved in the 29<sup>th</sup> NSQC held on 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2023

- 10. The Committee was apprised that the qualification 'Commercial Vehicle Driver (Heavy Motor Vehicle)', submitted by the Directorate General of Armoured Corps, was approved in 29<sup>th</sup> NSQC meeting. The Armoured Corps has thereafter rationalized the qualification by consolidating various job roles that require knowledge of heavy vehicle driving and including them as optional electives, tailored to suit the needs of other recognized Defense ABs as well as to make it more industry-relevant.
- 11. The revised qualification details are as below:

12. After considering the proposal, the Committee **accorded approval** to the revised

qualification.

AGENDA ITEM 06: Proposal to Accord Interim Approval to 28 Qualifications of Construction Skill Development Council of India (CSDCI) and Re-Activation of 9 Archived Qualifications

#### 13. Interim approval to 28 Revised Qualifications.

- 13.1. The Committee was apprised that NCVET had received 28 revised qualifications from CSDCI in June 2023 for extension of validity which would be expiring on 24<sup>th</sup> July 2023. To maintain continuity of the training and certification, it was proposed to grant interim approval to all 28 qualifications until 31st August 2023.
- 13.2. The Committee **accorded approval** for extension of validity to 28 qualifications till 31<sup>st</sup> August 2023 or till the revision of these qualifications whichever is earlier. The details of the Qualifications are attached as **Annexure IV.**

#### 14. Reactivation of 09 Qualifications

- 14.1. The Committee was informed that the National Urban Livelihood Mission (NULM) of the Government of Madhya Pradesh and the Uttar Pradesh Skill Development Mission (UPSDM) of the Government of Uttar Pradesh had requested CSDCI to assess and certify around 8000 learners who had undergone training in 11 NSQF aligned and approved qualifications of CSDCI.
- 14.2. The Committee was further apprised that 09 out of 11 job roles were archived by the NCVET in the 16<sup>th</sup> NSQC held on 24 February 2022, while the remaining 02 qualifications being obsolete, were deactivated on request of the CSDCI. As the provision exists to re-activate the archived qualifications subject to the AB concerned justifying its need and requirements in the ecosystem, it was proposed to reactivate 09 NSQF aligned and approved qualifications for a period of six months or till the pending assessment and certifications are completed, whichever is earlier. The balance 02 job roles ('Multi Skill Technician' and 'Fabrication and Tack welder') were declared obsolete by CSDCI and hence may not be considered for re-activation.
- 14.3. The Committee observed that some of the states are selecting de-activated and archived qualifications from National Qualifications Register (NQR) and from Skill India Portal (SIP). Furthermore, the Awarding Bodies whose qualifications are being selected are not contacted while selecting the qualifications. They contact the concerned ABs only when the assessment of their qualifications are due which is contrary to the Guidelines/ Policies on the subject.
- 14.4. The Committee also directed the NCVET to issue an advisory to all the SSDMs and SCVTs, as applicable, regarding selection of only active qualifications from the NQR/SIP as also to follow prescribed norms to ensure that minimum

training standard is maintained in the VET and skilling ecosystem.

- 14.5. In the instant case, since UPSDM as well as NULM of Madhya Pradesh have not adhered to the prescribed norms the Committee, therefore, **did not approve the re-activation of these 9 qualifications**. The Committee reiterated that the earlier decisions for enrolling in archived/ de-activated qualifications for the training, may be followed in letter and spirit and also cautioned the recognized ABs to refrain from undertaking assessment of any such qualifications, either undertaken through Govt scheme or Funded program, if the training norms have not been adhered to by any such entities.
- 14.6. The Committee further decided that the concerned implementing bodies in respective states may submit the details of the qualifications along with the other NSQF parameters followed for the training in consultation with the CSDCI and bring before the NSQC for appropriate decision on the proposal for assessment of these de-activated qualifications.

### AGENDA ITEM 07: Submission of Qualifications/ NOSs For NSQF Alignment

- 15. The Committee was given an account of 181 qualifications (151 New and 30 Revised), and 06 NOSs received till 29<sup>th</sup> April 2023 for NSQF alignment and approval as under:
  - 15.1. A total of **89 (60 New and 29 revised) out of 181 qualifications and 6 NOSs** were received from recognized ABs (Central Ministries/State Bodies/SSCs/Other Govt & Pvt Bodies). Of these, **82 qualifications (53 New and 29 revised) and** Six (06) standalone NOSs were considered for placing in the 30th NSQC as in the remaining qualifications the desired information and clarification are yet to be received from the awarding body concerned.
  - 15.2. A total of **92 qualifications (91 New and 01 revised)** were received from Indian Defense Forces (Tri-Services). Of these, **47 qualifications (46 New and 01 revised)** were considered for placing in the 30<sup>th</sup> NSQC. In addition, 27 qualifications were found to have the same nomenclature and NOSs (less than 20% changes) as of the existing NSQF aligned and approved qualification/ NOSs, thus may be leading to duplication. The balance18 qualifications have been returned with observations.
- 16. The decisions of the Committee on the above-mentioned qualifications and NOSs are given in succeeding paras. The detailed status of approval and decision of the Committee is at **Annexure V**

#### Awarding Bodies (Central Ministries/State Bodies/SSCs/Other Govt & Pvt Bodies).

17. **Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE):** One (01) new qualification, Page 5 of 25

'Fundamentals of Artificial Intelligence' was presented before the Committee. The Committee observed that it did not meet the NSQF parameters of a job role/Qualification, however it met the criteria for approval as NOS which was agreed upon by the Director, CBSE and therefore the proposed Qualification was approved as a standalone NOS.

- 18. **National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS):** One (01) new qualification presented before the Committee was approved.
- 19. **National Institute of Electronics & Information Technology (NIELIT):** One (01) revised qualification presented before the Committee was approved.
- 20. West Bengal State Council of Technical & Vocational Education and Skill Development WBSCTVESD: One (01) revised qualification presented before the Committee was approved.
- 21. **Broadcast Engineering Consultants India Limited (BECIL):** One (01) new qualification presented before the Committee was approved.
- 22. **Automotive Skills Development Council:** Four (04) new qualifications presented before the Committee were approved.
- 23. **Domestic Workers Sector Skill Council:** One (01) new qualification, 'Montessori School Facilitator cum Caregiver' was presented before the Committee. The Committee approved the qualification subject to a change in the nomenclature of the qualification to be generic as 'Play School Facilitator cum Caregiver' which was agreed upon by the CEO DWSSC.
- 24. **Electronics Sector Skills Council of India (ESSCI):** One (01) new qualification, namely 'Drone Assistant Technician' was presented before the Committee. The Committee approved the qualification subject to change in the nomenclature of the qualification to 'Assistant Drone Technician' which was agreed to by the CEO ESSCI.
- 25. Food Industry Capacity & Skill Initiative (FICSI). Five (05) new qualifications presented before the Committee were approved. The committee suggested changing the nomenclature of 'Lab Instrumentation Specialist' to 'Food Lab Instrumentation Specialist' and the same was agreed to by the CEO, FICSI.
- 26. **Handicrafts and Carpet Sector Skill Council:** Two (02) new qualifications and 14 revised qualifications were presented before the Committee and were approved subject to changes in the nomenclature and NSQF level of three qualifications **which was agreed to by the CEO, Handicrafts and Carpet Sector Skill Council.** Details are given as under:

- 27. **Hydrocarbon Sector Skill Council:** One (01) revised qualification presented before the Committee was approved.
- 28. **Rubber, Chemical & Petrochemical Skill Development Council:** Four (04) revised qualifications presented before the Committee were approved for the duration of **06 months only** for lack of insufficient number of trainings in last three years as per the prescribed norms.
- 29. **Sports, Physical Education, Fitness and Leisure Skills Council:** Ten (10) new qualifications presented before the Committee were approved.
- 30. **Water Management & Plumbing Skill Council:** Two (02) qualifications (1 new and 1 revised) presented before the Committee were approved.
- 31. **Shri Vishwakarma Skill University (SVSU):** Six (06) new qualifications presented before the Committee were approved.
- 32. **Maharaja Ranjit Singh Punjab Technical University:** One (01) new qualification presented before the Committee was approved subject to change in the nomenclature of the qualification from "Advance Certificate course in Industrial Automation and Control Systems in manufacturing" to "Industrial Automation and Control Systems Supervisor" which was agreed to by the AB.
- 33. **Maharishi Sandipini Rashtriya Ved Vidya Pratishthan:** Eleven (11) new qualifications presented before the Committee were given, **in principle, approval**. Some changes in the nomenclature of the qualifications, as indicated in the Table below, were suggested which was agreed to by the Awarding Body. The AB was also asked to get validations for the qualifications from similar Institutes/ Organisations of repute.

- 34. **Centurion University:** Three (03) new qualifications presented before the Committee were approved.
- 35. **HARTRON:** Five (05) revised qualifications presented before the Committee were approved.
- 36. **International Automotive Central of Excellence:** One (01) new qualification presented before the Committee was approved.
- 37. **Directorate General of Training:** One (01) new NOS presented before the Committee was approved.
- 38. **Handicrafts and Carpet Sector Skill Council:** Five (05) new NOSs presented before the Committee were approved.

#### **Indian Defense Forces**

- 39. **Indian Air Force:** Nine (09) new qualifications presented before the Committee were approved.
- 40. **Army Physical Training Corps:** Two (02) new qualifications presented before the Committee were approved.

- 41. **Army Service Corps:** One (01) new qualification was presented before the Committee and was approved.
- 42. **Armoured Corps:** Four (04) new qualifications presented before the Committee were approved. The Committee appreciated the efforts of the Directorate Armoured Corps and suggested all other ABs to consider a similar holistic approach while developing qualifications with electives.
- 43. **Corps of Signals:** Five (05) new qualifications were presented before the Committee were approved.
- 44. **Corps of Electronics & Mechanical Engineers:** Seven (07) new qualifications were presented before the Committee. Six (6) qualifications were **approved** and one (1) qualification was **not approved** (as similar qualification was existing among the approved 6 qualifications).
- 45. **Infantry:** Three (03) new qualifications presented before the Committee were approved.
- 46. **Mechanised Infantry:** Two (02) new qualifications were presented before the Committee. The Committee suggested either to adopt 'Laundry Associate' Qualification or change the nomenclature of the qualification to 'Laundry Associate (Defense)'. The suggestion to change the nomenclature was agreed to by the AB.
- 47. **Military Intelligence:** Four (04) new qualifications presented before the Committee were approved.
- 48. **Corps of Military Police:** Two (02) new qualifications presented before the Committee were approved. The committee suggested changing the name of the qualification 'Logistics Fleet Associate to 'Logistics Fleet Supervisor' and the same was agreed to by the AB.
- 49. **Regiment of Artillery:** Three (03) new qualifications presented before the Committee were approved.
- 50. **Remount Veterinary Corps:** Four (04) new qualifications presented before the Committee were approved. The committee suggested adding the word 'Advanced' to the name of all qualifications for distinguishing between these with Agriculture Skill Council's Qualifications and the same was agreed to by the AB.

#### AGENDA ITEM 08: ADDITIONAL AGENDA WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR

51. The Committee was informed that the qualification of 'Trainer-Persons with Disability (PwD)' for bringing quality and sensitivity in training of PwD was earlier approved in November 2020 as a 'Top Up' qualification over and above the trainer

qualification approved by the Domain SSC. The validity of the said qualification is expiring on 30.06.2023. In order to ensure continuity of the training and certification, the SCPwD has requested extension of validity for the qualification.

- 52. The committee accorded 'in principle' approval till 31st August 2023 or till the revision of the qualification to avoid disruption in the PwD training ecosystem. The qualifications may be placed for ratification in the next NSQC after detailed scrutiny.
- 53. The Committee was briefed that in the Meetings of 16th, 20th & 21<sup>st</sup> NSQCs held on 24<sup>th</sup> Feb, 30<sup>th</sup> June and 28<sup>th</sup> July 2022 all the recognized Awarding Bodies (AB) were advised to rationalize their existing NSQF aligned and approved qualifications in the multiples of 30 and include the Employability Skills (ES) in order to align with the National Credit Framework so that every learning hour is creditised as per the provisions of NCrF. Subsequently, Telecom SSC and Healthcare SSC has rationalized their 49 and 44 qualifications respectively.

The Committee took note of the above and ratified the same.

- 54. The Committee further instructed all the NCVET recognized ABs to upload their TOT & TOA calendars on the SIP portal and on their respective websites in the next 15 days i.e., till 8<sup>th</sup> July 2023. This would help address the challenge of shortage of trainers/ assessors in the skill ecosystem.
- 55. The Committee also suggested all the ABs to tie-up with the MSDE & DGT run Government Training Centers for implementing their TOT & TOA programs as these government organizations have better infrastructure, manpower resources, training systems, institutional capacities and deeper reach in the Vocational Education, Training and Skilling ecosystem.

# Submission of Duplicate Qualifications for NSQF Alignment & Approval by Awarding Bodies

- 56. It was brought to the notice of the Committee that some of the ABs pick up the NOSs from the existing NSQF aligned and approved Qualifications by making some cosmetic or insignificant changes (less than 20%) and submit to the NCVET as their newly developed qualifications. This is contrary to the Guidelines issued by NCVET on Adoption of Qualifications by Awarding Bodies. Such action not only leads to duplication of the qualification on NQR but also may mislead and confuse the learners and training institutes while selecting a qualification.
- 57. The Committee deliberated on the point raised by some of the recognized Awarding bodies and decided that a committee be constituted to analyze and address the concern raised in this meeting and during the various stakeholders' meetings and submit the recommendations at the earliest in true interest of VET & genuine skilling in the ecosystem.
