Name of the Course: Advanced Diploma in Android Application Development

Preamble: Android Application is a mobile software application developed for use on devices powered by Google's Android platform. The course has been designed to impart practical knowledge on Android application programming thus to reduce the gap between the demand and supply of Competent Android Application Developers.

Objective of the Course:

The course is a 3 month full time course suitable for fresh graduates seeking a quick jump start into the world of Android development. Students with working knowledge of C and Operating Systems are allowed to attend this course. The project work at the end of the course enables students to get an exposure to industrial standards.

Outcome of the Course:

This is a hands on course which provides participants with the information and lab experience necessary to develop and deploy Android applications. This course starts with core java and covers SQL programming and Android application Development.

More than 50% of the time will be devoted for guided practical sessions.

Other Contents

a. Course Fees:

General Candidates: Course fee is ₹ 31,250/- + GST at actuals

SC/ST Candidates: Tuition Fees/Examination fees are waived for SC/ST students admitted under SCSP/TSP. However they are required to remit an amount of ₹3,700/- as Advance caution/security deposit. This amount will be considered as caution/security deposit and will be refunded after successful completion of the course. If the student fails to complete the course successfully this amount along with any other caution/security deposits by the student will be forfeited.

b. **Registration Fee:** An amount of ₹1000/- should be paid at the time of registering for the course. The same will be considered as caution deposit on student joining the course. This advance deposit will not be refunded for a selected candidate who does not join the course.

Rs.1000/- will be considered as refundable caution deposit on student joining the course. This advance deposit will not be refunded for a selected candidate who does not join the course.

- g. **Selection of candidates**: Selection of candidates who have the requisite qualifying degree will be based on the percentage of marks in their qualifying degree subject to eligibility and availability of seats. Selection of candidates who have completed the course but expecting the results shall be based on the aggregate percentage of marks mentioned in their final mark list and on the availability of seats.

- j. **Spot Admission**: If spot admission is open, spot admission will close within 15 days of Counseling/Admission of a particular course. On spot admission students

should provide an undertaking saying that he/she is fully aware that he/she missed so much days of class and will not ask for extra classes or further extension of course.

k. Admission Procedure:

Students who have been selected for test/interview/counseling/admission are required to report to the Institute on the prescribed day by 9:30 hrs along with the following

- 1. Original and attested Copies of Proof of Age, Qualifications, etc
- 2. One passport size photograph and one stamp size photograph for identity card.
- 3. SC/ST Certificate (Original and attested copies, if applicable)
- 4. Income Certificate (Original and attested copy, if applicable)

The students on reaching the Institute are required to meet the Front Office Councilor (FOC). The FOC then directs the student to the Course Coordinator. The student gets the certificates and enrollment form verified by the Course Coordinator and then meets the FOC who shall direct the student to the Accounts for payment of fees. A student is thus admitted, attested copies of all documents shall be handed over to the Course Coordinator.

1. **Discontinuing the course:** No fees (including the caution deposit) under any circumstances, shall be refunded in the event of a student discontinuing the course. No certificate shall be issued for the classes attended.

A student can however, be eligible for module certificates (applicable only for courses which provide for modular admission) which he has successfully completed provided, he/she has paid the entire course fees. This is not applicable to SC/ST candidates availing fee concession. SC/ST candidates availing fee concession are eligible for module certificates only after completing the full course with required attendance

n. Location and how to reach:

NIELIT Calicut is located very close to NIT campus and is about 22Kms from the Calicut (Kozhikode) city. A number of buses (Buses to NIT via Kunnamangalam) are available from "Palayam Bus Stand and KSRTC Bus Stand". The bus stop at our Institute is called "Panthrand" and is one stop before NIT. The bus fare is around ₹.17/- from Calicut City to NIELIT.

q. Placement:

Our Placement Cell provides placement assistance to students who qualify our courses. This course helps the students to improve their technical and practical knowledge which enable them to apt for the industry requirements. Also, Our Placement Cell conducts weekly placement test and mock interviews to enhance the student's confidence to face the industry based tests and interviews. The students are getting placed by,

- Campus placement
- Forward the collected resumes of students to companies, who approach us for their manpower requirements,
- Students themselves attend interview at different companies with recommendation letters/certificates of the course.

About 80% of students are already placed in various companies like Wipro, TCS, Samsung, BDI Systems, Cognizant, Fujitsu, Ospyn Technologies and many more.

r. Hostel facilities:

Hostel accommodation is available for boys and girls on monthly or daily chargeable basis. The hostel fee varies from Rs.1,400 /- to Rs.1,500/-- per month depending on the type of accommodation. However, students are required to pay the hostel fees for the duration of the course for which they are seeking admission at the time of joining the course.

s. Canteen facilities:

Canteen & Mess facility is available for both boys & girls, students, those who avail mess facility should pay monthly mess fee @Rs.130/- per day. An amount

of Rs.1,000/- should be paid as mess advance to the Canteen Contractor at the time of joining the mess which will be adjusted in the last month mess fee.

An amount of Rs.3,000/- should be paid as caution deposit (hostel & mess) at the time of joining the hostel which will be refunded/adjusted at the end of the course.

t. Lab Facilities:

The IT Lab is equipped with high-end Intel Xeon Dual Processor based servers and more than 100 networked PCs with internet facility. A variety of software is available which include Windows OS all versions and applications, MSDN Subscription, Adobe CS Master Collection, Rational Rose, VMWare, Kylix, Cold Fusion and multimedia development tools. The 24x7 Wi-Fi campus enables the students to get on-line anywhere on campus.

u. Course Contents:

Core Java

Introduction to Java Platform, Data Types, Variables, Arrays, Operators, Control Statements, Java Classes and Objects, Methods, Inheritance, Packages and Interfaces, Exception Handling, Threads and Multi Threading, I/O, String Handling, Java.Lang, Collections, Network Programming, Java AWT, Event Handling, Applets, Graphics, JDBC.

Android Application

Introduction to Android, Development Environment, Emulator-Android virtual device, UI Design- Activities, Layouts, Menus, Styles and Themes, Debugging Android applications, intents and Notification services, Content Providers-SQLite, Adapters and Widgets, Multimedia, Location based services, Packaging and deployment.

Project

Students are required to develop an Android application under the guidance of the faculty. Students can also take up relevant projects from the industry.
