

Substituting or replacing all occurrences of the pattern in a file

To replace all the occurrences of the search pattern in the file, use the `/g` flag. The `/g` is the global replacement.

```
#sed 's/Linux/Unix/g' linuxgeek.txt
```

Output

```
root@ubuntu:~# sed 's/Linux/Unix/g' linuxgeek.txt
Unix is a free and opensource operating system. Unix is a powerful OS.
Unix is also a multi user system. Many software developers code on Unix.
Unix  comes in many flavors.
With Unix you can accomplish administrative tasks without much hassle.
