### 1. ON GOING ACTIVITIES OF THE CENTRE

DOEACC Centre Srinagar/Jammu conducts both formal and non-formal long-term courses approved by AICTE-MHRD in addition to the practical oriented, industry sought short-term courses for the skill enhancement of students and professionals.

- The Centre annually trains 500 candidates through long-term courses and over 5000 candidates including working professionals, government employees, Defense personnels for their skill Upgradation through various short-term training programs.
- The Centre conducts MCA program, approved by AICTE and in affiliation with University of Kashmir and DOEACC courses like

  Bq and also MCA/BCA of IGNOU.
- It has become an ISO 9001:2008 certified organization in offering Education & Training in IECT sector.
- It has forged academic tie-ups with organizations like Oracle for its Workforce Development Program and CISCO for offering CISCO academy courses both at Srinagar and Jammu.
- Under Continuing Distance Engineering Education Program (CDEEP) it has become remote Centre of IIT Bombay for receiving their live classroom lectures through EDUSAT.
- The Centre continues to play a lead role as IT advisors to Govt. of J&K in the implementation of various IT initiatives under NeGP and as a member of Jammu Kashmir e-governance agency (J&KeGA)

#### 2. NEW INITIATIVES IMPLEMENTED DURING THE YEAR

### 2.1 AICTE approval of MCA program in affiliation with University of Kashmir.

The MCA program of the Centre being offered in affiliation with University of Kashmir was approved by All India Council for Technical Education with an intake capacity of 60 seats.

#### 2.2 ISO 9001-2008 Certification.

The Centre has become an ISO 9001:2008 certified organization in Design, Development, Delivery, Evaluation and Approval of Education and Training Programs in Information Electronics and Communication Technology (IECT), Development of

Software and Hardware Products, Project Consultancy in IECT. The certification was done by DAS UK.

#### 2.3 Launch of CCC for Jail inmates in major prisons of J&K State

As an outcome of measures taken to popularize CCC in J&K state, Director General of Prisons, Govt. of J&K launched CCC program for Jail inmates in major prisons of J&K state including District Jail Jammu, Central Jail Kotbhalwal Jammu, and Central Jail Srinagar.

# 2.4 Conduct of Online Examination for Certificate Course on Computing Concepts (CCC) Exam.

During the year, the Centre established **26 examination venues** across two states i.e., J&K & Uttaranchal and **enrolled 3184 candidates** in the CCC online examination conducted in June-09, Oct-09 and Feb. 2010.

# 2.5 Training of J&K Police under Crime & Criminal Tracking Network & Systems (CTNS) project

A four-week training program under CCTNS project was organized for 559 J&K police personnel at various locations in J&K state

### 2.6 Training of Airforce warrior's stationed at Srinagar & Awantipora.

Four-week training programs on Computer Networking & Basic Computer Application were organized for 272 employees of Indian Airforce stationed at Srinagar and Awantipora.

# 2.7. 'O' level training of SC/ST candidates sponsored by Director General of Employment & Training, Ministry of Labour and Employment.

The Centre implemented the scheme of training 100 SC/ST candidates (in two batches of 50 each) sponsored by Director General of Employment & Training, Ministry of Labour and Employment.

### 2.8. Launch of CCNP program

The Centre has been granted CISCO academy status for conducting CCNA the flagship program of CISCO both at Srinagar and Jammu. Following the upgrading of the infrastructure at both the places, the Centre has now launched CCNP modules.

- Association with CSCs for collaborating under e-learning mode.


### 9 CCNA training Program sponsored by Science & Technology Department.
