

ESDM Scheme



Accreditation of Training Partner (TP)

- Training partners can be
 - Existing CHM O/A level accredited institutes
 - Existing AICTE/ Central/ State Government/ Technical Board/ Polytechnic/ ITIs / NCVT and other private Institutions
- Training shall be in existence for last 2 years.
- Class and Lab of 40 Sq mtrs each is required.
- Must have facility for online examination
- Existing hardware infrastructure shall be preferred to use available for various institutions like ITIs/ Polytechnics / Engineering colleges etc
- NIELIT RCs can also act as a training partner



Conduct of Training

- Training to be imparted at the TPs location.
- TP need to first register on the ESDM portal esdmskill.deity.gov.in
- Candidate shall be mobilized by TP with support from SIA/ NIELIT RC
- AADHAAR is Mandatory. However, for enrollment of the candidate EID can also be used.
- TP may tie-up with industry for hands on training & placements
- A candidate can get the benefit of the scheme only once
- It is advisable for TPs ensure that the candidate is willing to get placed or employed as the training is employment linked.

- Training Partner can charge only 25% of the Training fee from General candidates.
- Registration cum certification fee need to be borne by the candidates initially and would be reimbursed back to him via DBT once he/ she is certified except candidates under Scheme-1 registered before 31st March 2015 as their fee would be reimbursed directly to KIA for their 1st Attempt



Examination and Certification of Candidates

- NIELIT would conduct Online Theory Examination as well as Practical assessment of the candidates
- There is also a provision of Internal Marks awarded by the Training Partners
- Digitally Signed Certificates would be issued by NIELIT HQ for the candidates enrolled in the NIELIT Courses
- All the Regional centres are requested to Submit at least 100 Questions of each course for creating pool of question bank for various course
- A candidate would be given a total of three attempts (including 2 re-appears) to clear the examination within 1 year from the date of Registration.
- Examination form processing is on the lines of CCC examination with following revenue share

Training Fee Reimbursement to TPs

- 50% of due Training fee would be reimbursed on the certification of the candidate for the certified candidates
- Remaining 50% of the training fee would be reimbursed after meeting the 70% criteria of Placement of the certified candidates
- No Training fee would be reimbursed for the non certified candidates
- The fee would be reimbursed by SIA in case of Scheme-1 and by PMU in case of Scheme-2
- The upper limit of claiming the balance 50% training fee reimbursement against placement is within 1 year after certification of the candidate.



Certification Fee Reimbursement

- For Scheme-1
 - 100% fee would be reimbursed to KIA by PMU for 1st attempt of examination for the candidates registered before 31-March-2015
 - For others it would be DBT directly to the candidate by PMU
- For Scheme-2
 - 75% of fee would be reimbursed via DBT to General category candidates and 100% to reserved category candidates by PMU



Placement of the Candidates

- No Exemption in placement criteria is provided in the scheme even if the candidate is going for Higher studies / courses.
- Placement details have to be mandatorily entered on the ESDM Skill Development Portal post placements of the candidates.
- The TP has to track the placement of the candidate for at least two months before putting in the request for fee reimbursement from PMU.
- In case of Self Employment, a certificate of self employment may be obtained from the candidate for reimbursement of fee purposes. The details of self-employment like place of work, contact details etc are to be provided.
- After 2 months of the employment of the first student of a respective batch, Training Partner to submit the offer letter/Certificate of Self-employment along with proof of continued employment/Self-Employment (e.g. Salary slips/ Bank statement of candidate showing salary transfer / Salary or Income certificate of at least 2 months) in order to claim the reimbursement.
- As the success of the scheme is measured in terms of placement, the TP will ensure liaison with local industry and may even go for the 'place and train' methodology.
