Memorandum of Understanding

Preamble

This MoU entered into and executed on the 10th October 2022 between Indian Institute of Management Raipur (hereinafter called "IIM Raipur") and National Institute of Electronics & Information Technology (hereinafter called "NIELIT").

About NIELIT

National Institute of Electronics & Information Technology, an autonomous Scientific Society under Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MeitY), Government of India, having its office at NIELIT Bhawan, Plot No. 3 PSP Pocket, Sector 8, Dwarka, New Delhi-110077, hereinafter called NIELIT, which expression shall, where the context so admits, be deemed to include its successors, executors and administrators of the ONE PART.

NIELIT offers, inter alia, various Training Programs both in the Formal and Non- Formal sector in the field of IECT to equip the students with necessary knowledge of the key industry practices and skills to be fruitfully employed besides providing exposure to live projects and hands-on practical training through its 47 own centers, spread across the country besides a network of more than 800+ Accredited Training Partners and about 5000+ CCC/BCC facilitation centers. NIELIT is also one of the National Examination Body, which accredits institutes/organizations for conducting courses in IT in the non-formal sector.

About IIM Raipur

Indian Institute of Management (IIM) has been set up by the Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development (now known as Ministry of Education) in 2010 at Raipur, the capital of Chhattisgarh. Presently IIM Raipur operates from the Government Engineering College Campus, Raipur.

The focus here is to predominantly train the new generation to face and excel in the challenges and opportunities that arise rapidly today and tomorrow. Currently IIM Raipur is running the courses mentioned below:

Doctoral Programmes:

- Fellow Programme in Management (Ph.D.)
- Executive Fellow Programme in Management (EFPM)

Post Graduate Programme:

- Post Graduate Programme (MBA)
- Executive Post-Graduate Programme (ePGP)

Apart from these, the Institute offers tailor-made In-Company executive development Programs for Senior and Middle level executives of different organizations including Private, Public and Government Sectors, to maximize their potential by gaining or refining their Management Skills. IIM Raipur offer Management Development Programs (MDP) in different area in management to reflect the evolving realities of business and management practices. IIM Raipur also offers Advance Management Development Programs that consist of overseas learning Program (OLP) in tie up with global & International Business Schools and Institutions.



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Whereas, both parties viz. IIM Raipur and NIELIT realize that in the current context, working together is desirable, therefore, both parties are agreeable to enter into a MOU for working and cooperating with one another and using their respective expertise, knowledge and resources.

Scope of MOU

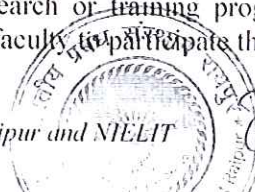
This Memorandum of Understanding is signed between the NIELIT as First Party and IIM Raipur as Second Party for the purpose of Academic Collaboration that will encompass exchange of students and members of faculty between the two parties as well as other academic activities, research and publication. In addition to these, active efforts will be made to develop joint training and research programmes that will be pursued in a collaborative spirit. Some of the collaborative areas include the following:

- Faculty Development Programme
- Development of joint programs for creating a pool of industry ready students & enhancing the skill sets of working professionals.
- Student Internship and Short Term Project
- Joint Consulting Projects
- Joint Research
- Case Writing

This list is illustrative and not exhaustive.

I. Terms and Conditions of Cooperation:

1. NIELIT and IIM Raipur shall collaborate in mutually agreeable academic events, teaching, training and research, wherever feasible. Such collaboration will be based on mutually agreeable terms and conditions specifically agreed for each of the collaborative efforts:
2. NIELIT and IIM Raipur shall offer full time regular as well as optional courses to the students on mutually agreeable terms and conditions:
3. Jointly organize workshops and interactive sessions for faculty discussions to promote research and teaching collaborations.
4. Exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programs. Students and fellows of both the institutes would be allowed to make use of library resources and to have academic interaction with the faculty of both the institutes as well.
5. Jointly organize workshops and short-term education program on topics of mutual interest to the third parties and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.
6. Jointly organize certificate courses, management development programs (MDP) for corporate bodies and government employees which are tailor made for their needs and specifications.
7. Jointly provide research and consultancy to government and other statutory Bodies, as and when required.
8. Undertake research on specific issues of interest to the third parties and publish briefing papers and research reports.
9. Jointly propose and engage in research or training programmes sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.



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10. Any financial implication emerging out of such collaborations (other than the fees of the students etc.) shall be worked out and decisions will be taken with mutual agreement.

II Areas of Cooperation:

This Memorandum expresses a mutual desire by NIELIT and IIM Raipur cooperates in building intellectual and research capacity and scholarship. Additional areas of co-operation may be added by written consent of the two the parties. Both parties will act in good faith to ensure that the objectives in this Memorandum are realized.

III. Terms of Agreement

Progress in realizing the terms and conditions referred to herein will be reviewed periodically as mutually agreed and the memorandum may be amended at any time by mutual consent and in writing. Both parties reserve the right to terminate this memorandum by either party by giving six months written notice to the other. The implementation and/or continuance of programmes or projects established pursuant to this memorandum prior to the effective date of termination shall not be affected by the termination of this Memorandum.

IV. Intellectual Property and Confidentiality

In respect of each project and programme of co-operation, the parties shall negotiate and mutually agree in writing on their respective rights to intellectual property and commercial exploitation of the same (including without limitation, trademarks and service marks, copyrights, patents, designs and confidential information pertaining thereto).

Neither party shall, at any time disclose to any third party any confidential information of the other party which is acquired in the course of activities under this Memorandum, a collaborative project or a programme, without the prior consent of the other party in writing.

The confidentiality obligations herein will not apply to information in the public domain; information in the possession of the receiving party prior to the disclosure of the information; information which is independently developed by the receiving party; information required to be released by law; and information which is rightfully received by the receiving party from third parties without any breach of confidentiality obligations.

V. Non-Binding Nature of Memorandum

Nothing in this Memorandum shall be construed as creating any contract, partnership, agency or other legal relationship between the parties. This Memorandum is only a non-binding statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

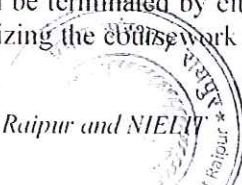
VI. Termination

This memorandum shall come into force immediately upon its signature by the parties.

The validity of this Memorandum of Understanding is initially for a period of five years from the date of its execution and the same can be further extended on mutual agreement.

This Memorandum of Understanding can be terminated by either of the parties by giving advance notice of six months and without jeopardizing the coursework or registration of any of the students of either institution.
