## **Webinar on Intellectual Property Rights and Engineering Research and Plagiarism**

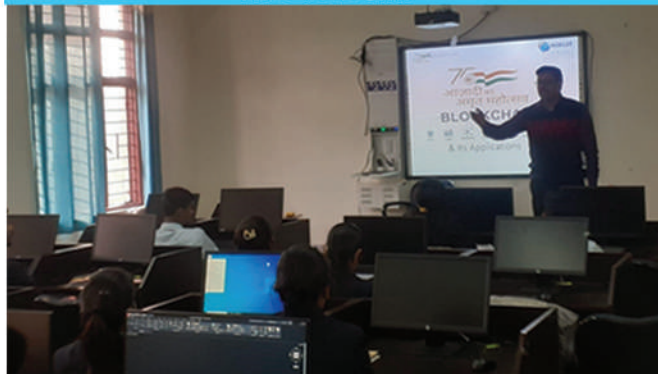

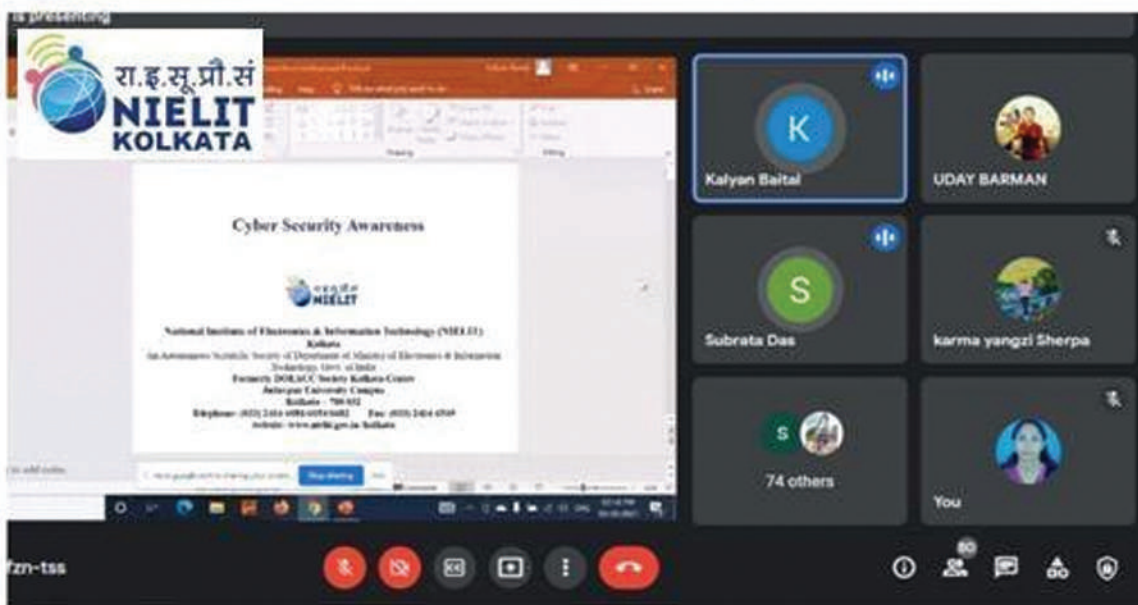
## Awareness Training Program on Cyber Forensics

## Workshop on “Digital Payment and Cyber Security” for the Students and Residents of Remote Village of Uttarakhand

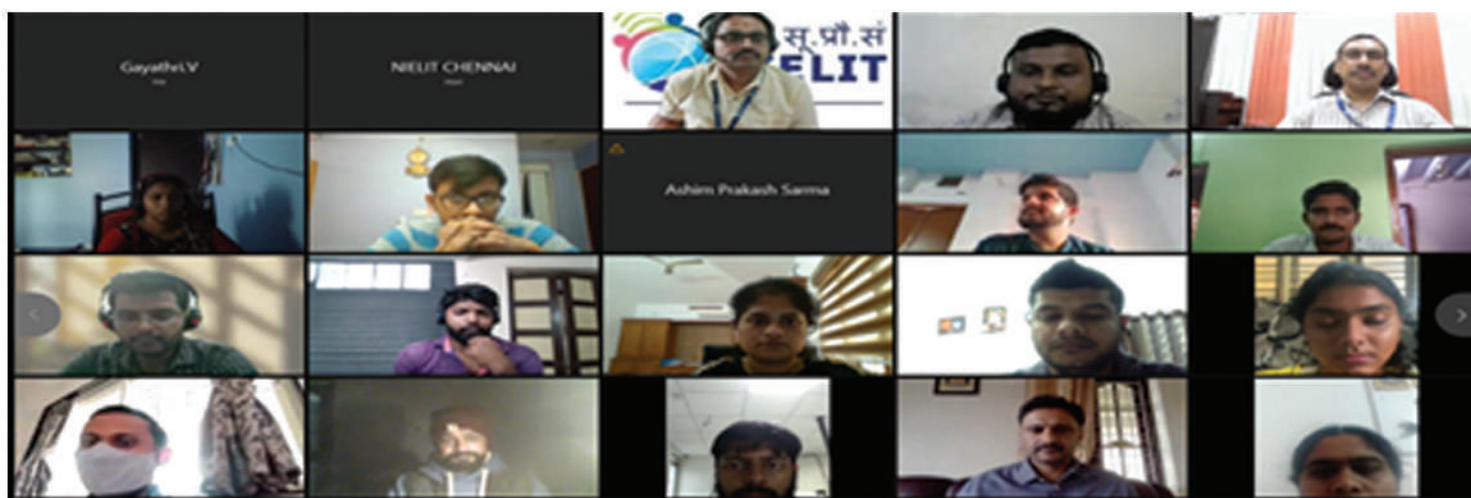

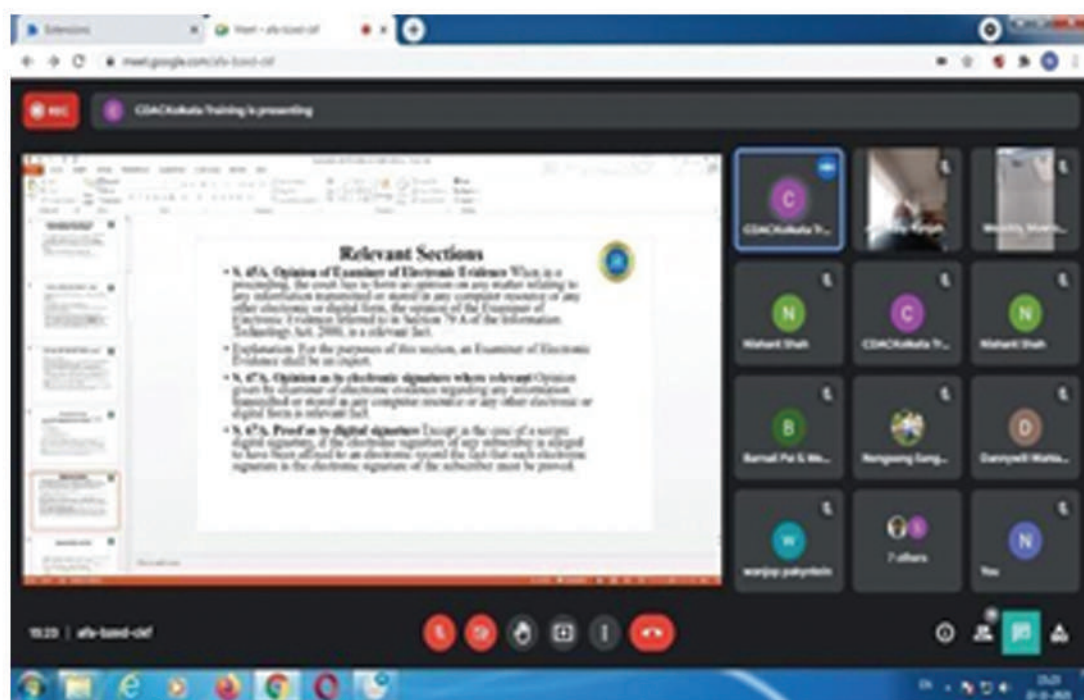

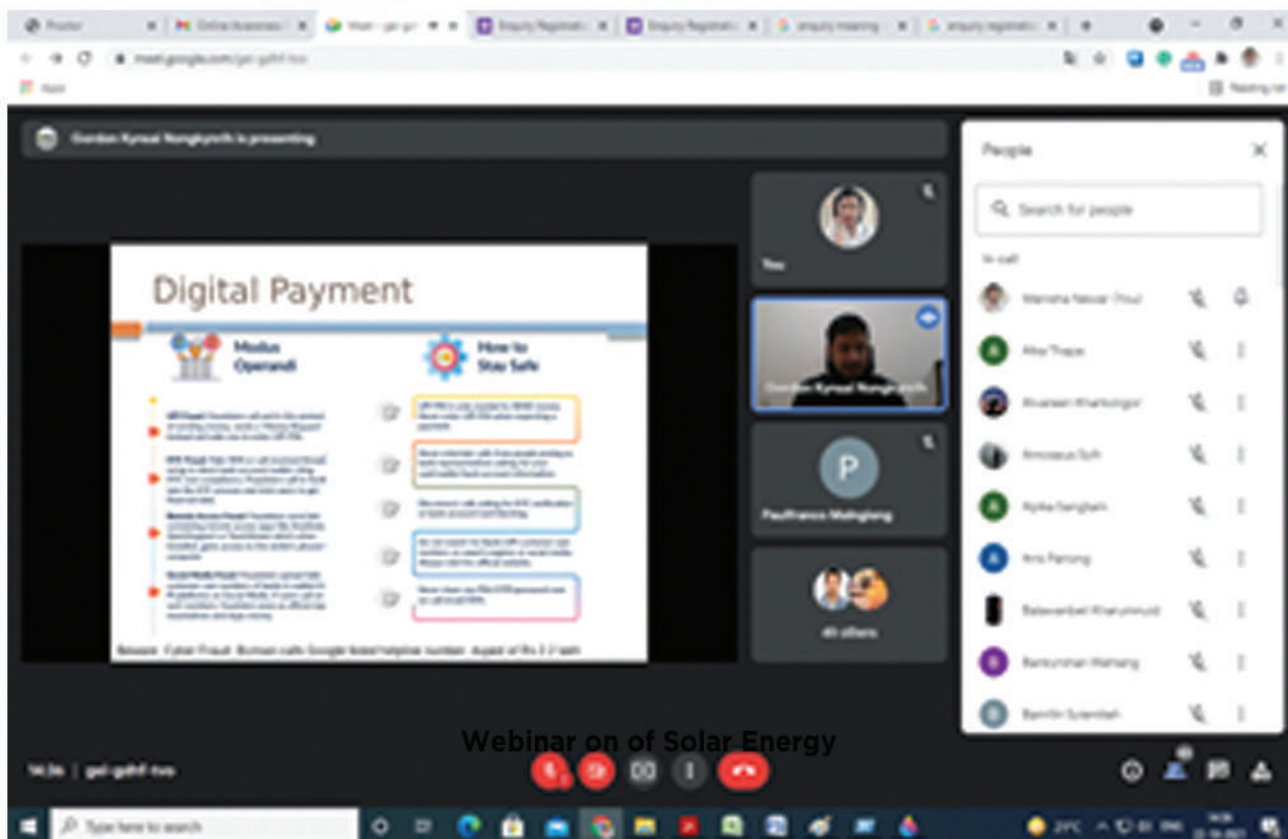
## **Offline Awareness Programme on Cyber Security**

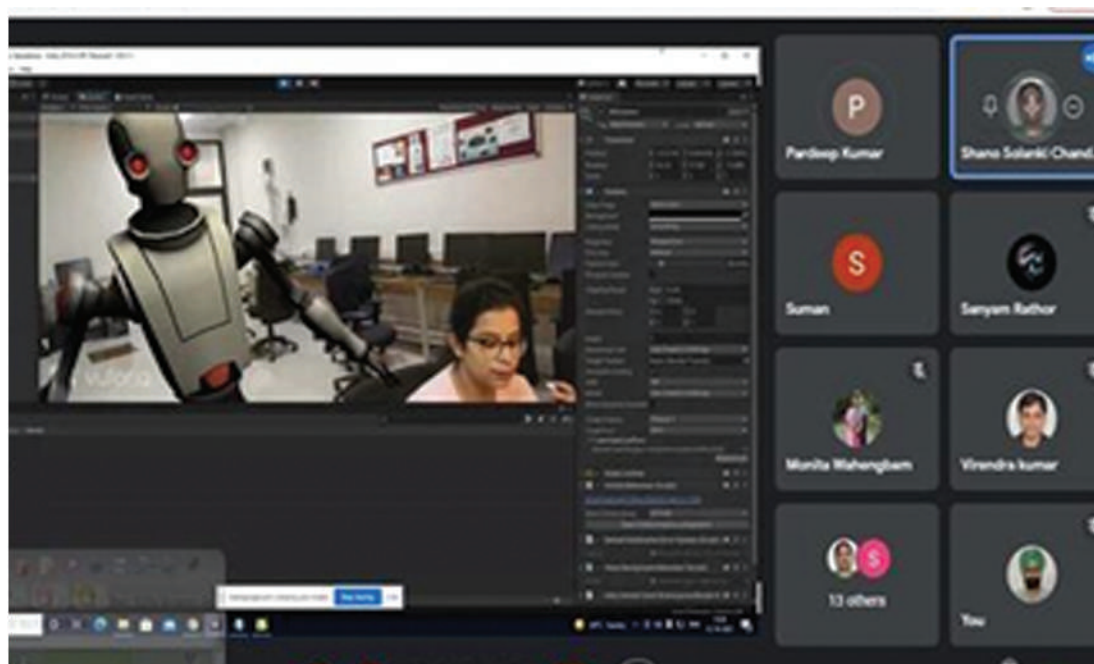
## **Skill Development of SC / ST/ EWS (Woman) Youths in Aspirational Districts in Area of IECT Leading to Enhancement in Employability**

## R&D Projects & Innovation

### NIELIT Calicut Bagged DRDO Funded Project

NIELIT Calicut has been awarded a research and development project from Naval Research Board (NRB) Defence Research and Development Organization (DRDO). The project execution will be in collaboration with Naval Physical and Oceanographic Laboratory (NPOL) Cochin. As part of the project, NIELIT Calicut will be developing hardware solutions for realizing complex signal processing algorithms on various platforms like Field Programmable Gate Array (FPGA), Multi-Core SoC, Graphics Processing Unit (GPU), etc. The project is for three years with a budget outlay of 45 lakhs.

### NIELIT Calicut to Setup a “SMART Hardware Remote Facility” as Part of SMDP ‘Chips to Start-up’ Project of MeitY

To meet the growing demand on self-reliance in Semiconductor Technology in the country, the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY)'s Government of India, approved the project titled “SPECIAL MANPOWER DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME FOR CHIPS TO START-UP” (SMDP - C2S) with a total project outlay of 250 Crore over a period of five years. NIELIT Calicut is identified as one of the participating institutes under this initiative. In addition, the ministry has approved the setting up of a SMART Hardware Remote Lab & carry-out Instructors Enhancement Programme (IEP) at NIELIT Calicut with a budgetary support of 6 Crore. Dr. M P Pillai, Executive Director NIELIT Calicut said that this will enable networking between important technical institutes, industries in India and will enhance the knowledge pool, which will make India self-reliant in Chip manufacturing. Dr. Jayaraj U Kidav, Scientist D, is the Principal Investigator of this project.



### **NIELIT Aurangabad Teams Declared Runners-up in Grand Challenge Contest 2021**

Ministry of Electronics & IT (MeitY) - Grand Challenge Contest 2021 was organised by Centre for Development of Advanced Computing (CDAC), Noida in association with India Cellular & Electronics Association (ICEA) for product design and development for Mobile handset accessories for CoE to energize young minds and develop indigenous innovative commercially viable product designs which can be upscaled further under this CoE.

A total of 1409 Registrations were received to CoE and 577 Synopsis were received. Out of these 446 Synopsis were shortlisted for Design and 186 Participants submitted their designs to CoE. Evaluation parameters for identification of winners for the Design were Design originality, Functionality and Innovation and commercialization aspects.

NIELIT Aurangabad submitted a total of 3 product designs out of total 7 product categories and all the three projects P-005 (To Design a Low-Cost Smart Light System), P-002 (To Design a Low-Cost USB Charger) and P-003 (To Design a Low-Cost Wireless Charger) have been declared as runners-up in the Problem Statements in the respective categories. All the Jury emphasized that these ideas have high potential and they are looking forward to hearing about these products as to be implemented in the Prototype Phase. Funding amount will be given for prototyping of these 3 selected Product designs into actual products to the selected teams of NIELIT Aurangabad that participated in this Grand Challenge contest 2021.

## INDUSTRY/ACADEMIA COLLABORATION

### **Agreement with Shyam Lal College, University of Delhi**

NIELIT Delhi Centre signed an agreement with Shyam Lal College, University of Delhi on 27<sup>th</sup> December, 2021 for providing the training to the students of Shyam Lal College for short term add-on courses in IT. 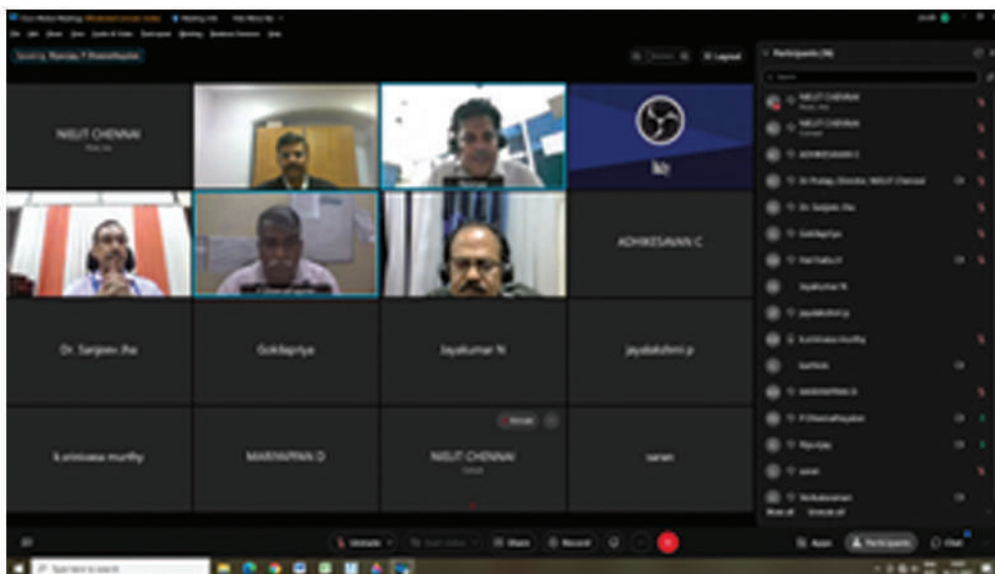
## Observation of Vigilance Awareness Week

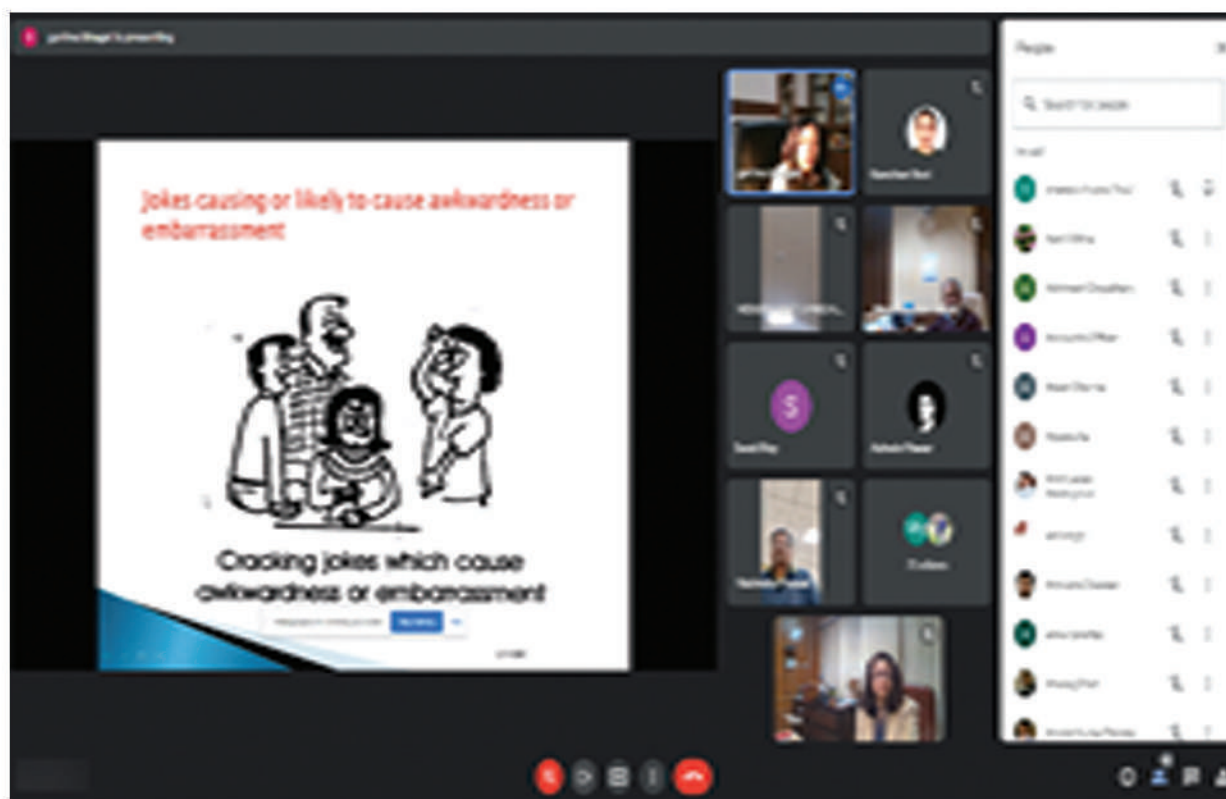
## Swachhta Abhiyan
