


Two Weeks course in "Advanced Java"

Corporate Training for Officials of Lok Sabha Secretariat



About 300 SC/ST/EWS (women) candidates are undergoing training in the NSQF Aligned courses 'Certificate course in data entry and office automation', 'Diploma in installation and repair of consumer electronics products', 'Advance diploma in computer application accounting and publishing', and 'Solar-LED lighting product (Design and manufacturing)' through training partners.

Webinar on 3D Printing for Dental Applications Under Future Skills Prime Project

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
