The app is currently available in Hindi, English, 16 regional languages, and 7 international languages Spanish, French, German, Russian, Mandarin-Chinese, Basha-Indonesian and Arabic.

## Expert Talk on "Artificial Intelligence and Metaverse"



### Workshops Conducted during Digital India Week




NIELIT Chennai has conducted 5 different workshops during the Digital India Week 2023.



## Bootcamp on Drone Communication and Security

NIELIT Srinagar Centre organized two bootcamp training programs as part of the "Capacity Building for Human Resource Development in Unmanned Aircraft System (Drone and related Technologies)" project, which is funded by the HRD Division of the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), Government of India.



### 1. Drone Programming and Simulation Bootcamp (Bootcamp 2.0):

- Duration: 5 days (40 hours), from July 24, 2023 to July 28, 2023.
- Participants: 33
- Objective: The primary goal of this bootcamp was to introduce and sensitize students and professionals to the fundamentals of Drone Programming and Simulation. It covered essential aspects of software development for controlling and monitoring unmanned aircraft systems, with a focus on practical demonstrations and hands-on experience.

### 2. Drone Communication and Security Bootcamp (Bootcamp 3.0):

- Duration: from September 4 to September 9, 2023.
- Participants: 34
- Collaboration: This bootcamp was conducted in collaboration with Govt. College for Women Nawakadal Srinagar.
- Objective: The focus of the bootcamp was on Drone Communication and Security, with an emphasis on utilizing flight simulators, flight stack software, and formal security validation tools. The program was designed for undergraduate and postgraduate students from diverse academic backgrounds, including BE, B.Tech., BCA, and MCA. Its primary objective was to introduce these students to the fundamentals of Drone Communications and Security through practical demonstrations and hands-on activities.



Both bootcamps were significant initiatives in the field of unmanned aircraft systems, providing valuable training and education to participants in the areas of drone programming, simulation, communication, and security.



### Observance of World Entrepreneurship Day at NIELIT Imphal





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
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
