National Institute of Electronics & Information Technology (NIELIT), is a premier Institution for Training, Examination and Certification in IECT area (under the administrative control of Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MeitY), Government of India) and is carrying out Capacity Building and Skill Development activities nation wide through a network of its own Centres/ Extension Centres at 35 Location and wide network of 900+ Accredited Institutes and 9000 facilitation Centres.

Looking to the requests received from many State Governments for setting up NIELIT Centres, with the approval of the Hon'ble Minister of Electronics & Information Technology, Government of India and Chairperson, Governing Council (NIELIT), following policy has been drawn for opening of new NIELIT Centres/Extension Centres:

Permanent Campus	Only on the basis of performance of the Centre/Extension Centre in initial 3 years of starting operations from built-up space

Location of Land	Within municipal limits of the city or within 2 Km outside municipal limits with availability of approach road, electricity and water etc. on site by State Government
