NOTIFICATION

Subject: 5th revision of A Level Syllabus in Information Technology

This notification is being issued in suppression of all the earlier notifications issued regarding revision of NIELIT (erstwhile DOEACC) A Level Course in Information Technology by National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT).

- 2. By this notification, it is notified for the general public including all stake-holders that the 5^{th} revision of A Level Syllabus in Information Technology will be effective for teaching from January 2020. The detailed revised syllabus is available at the website link http://nielit.gov.in/content/computer-course-0 .
- 3. The First examination based on this syllabus will be held in July 2020. Candidates undergoing training/examinations as per the existing syllabus (4th revised syllabus) will be provided maximum two chances to complete the course as per the 4^{th} revised syllabus. With effect from July 2020, examinations based on existing syllabus (4th revised syllabus) and 5^{th} revised syllabus shall be held concurrently for two examinations (July 2020 and January 2021 examinations). Thereafter, from July 2021, the examinations based on the existing syllabus (4th revised syllabus) will be discontinued and examinations will be held only as per the 5^{th} revised syllabus for A level.
- 4. Such candidates who are unable to complete the course as per the 4^{th} revised syllabus, shall have to compulsorily appear in the 5^{th} revised syllabus from July 2021 examination based on the parity table given in the 5^{th} revised syllabus. Already registered candidates will also have the option to shift from the existing syllabus (4^{th} revision) to the 5^{th} revised syllabus immediately, based on the parity table.
