## **NOTIFICATION**

Subject: 5<sup>th</sup> revision of IT Application Engineer (B Level-IT) Syllabus

This notification is being issued in suppression of all the earlier notifications issued regarding revision of NIELIT (erstwhile DOEACC) IT Application Engineer (B Level-IT) Course by National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT).

- 2. By this notification, it is notified for the general public including all stake-holders that the 5<sup>th</sup> revision of IT Application Engineer (B Level-IT) Syllabus will be effective for teaching from January 2023. The detailed revised syllabus is available at the website link <a href="http://nielit.gov.in/content/computer-course-0">http://nielit.gov.in/content/computer-course-0</a>. This qualification has been approved by NCVET, MSDE in its 22<sup>nd</sup> Meeting of the NSQC and aligned at Level-6 of NSQF in IT/ITeS Sector. Further, on recommendation of NCVET, the qualification name of B Level has been changed from Master Diploma in Computer Application to IT Application Engineer (B Level IT).
- 3. The First examination based on this syllabus will be held in July 2023. Candidates undergoing training/examinations as per the existing syllabus (4th revised syllabus) will be provided maximum two chances to complete the course as per the 4<sup>th</sup> revised syllabus. With effect from July 2023, examinations based on existing syllabus (4th revised syllabus) and 5<sup>th</sup> revised syllabus shall be held concurrently for two examinations (July 2023 and January 2024 examinations). Thereafter, from July 2024, the examinations based on the existing syllabus (4th revised syllabus) will be discontinued and examinations will be held only as per the 5<sup>th</sup> revised syllabus for IT Application Engineer (B Level-IT).
- 4. Such candidates who are unable to complete the course as per the 4<sup>th</sup> revised syllabus, shall have to compulsorily appear in the 5<sup>th</sup> revised syllabus from July 2024 examination based on the parity table given in the 5<sup>th</sup> revised syllabus. Already registered candidates will also have the option to shift from the existing syllabus (4<sup>th</sup> revision) to the 5<sup>th</sup> revised syllabus immediately, based on the parity table.
