- 2. The assessor assigns roll number.
- 3. The assessor carries out theory online assessments. Theory examination would be conducted online and the paper comprise of MCQ
- 4. Pass percentage would be 50% marks.
- 5. The examination will be conducted in English language only.

Quality assurance activities: A pool of questions is created by a subject matter expert and moderated by other SME. Test rules are set beforehand. Random set of questions which are according to syllabus appears which may differ from candidate to candidate. Confidentiality and impartiality are maintained during all the examination and evaluation processes.
