# MINUTES OF THE 4<sup>th</sup> MEETING OF NATIONAL SKILLS QUALIFICATIONS COMMITTEE (NSQC) OF NCVET HELD ON 24th December, 2020

- 1. The fourth meeting of the National Skills Qualifications Committee (NSQC) under National Council of Vocational Education and Training (NCVET) was held on 24th December, 2020 through video-conferencing, under the Chairpersonship of Shri. Praveen Kumar, Chairperson, NCVET & Secretary, MSDE. The list of participants is at Annexure-1.
- 2. The decision taken in the meeting are as follows:

#### AGENDA ITEM 1: CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF THE 3<sup>rd</sup> MEETING OF NSQC

3. The Committee approved the minutes of the 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting of NSQC held on 20<sup>th</sup> November 2020. The Chairman suggested that for any objections to the NSQC minutes issued, a mail may be sent at the first opportunity to the Council instead of waiting for the next NSQC meeting, so that necessary action can be taken and revision can be brought with immediate effect.

# AGENDA ITEM 2: ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON THE MINUTES OF THE 3<sup>rd</sup>MEETING OF NSQC

- 4. The NSQC was given an account of the actions taken on the Minutes of the 3<sup>rd</sup> NSQC meeting. The status of conditionally approved files with respect to compliance is at Annexure II.
- 5. Paragraph wise details of "Action Taken Report" mentioned as under were again deliberated, and decision taken on them are as under:-
  - (a) <u>S.No. 1.2 (c): Instrumentation SSC:</u> Since concurrence of line Ministry on two out of four files have been received, same may be processed for uploading on the National Qualification Register (NQR)
  - (b) <u>S.No. 1.2 (f): Creation of a Separate Section on NQR for PwD</u>: The Committee was apprised that a separate sector in respect of PwD has been created on the NQR Website and approved qualification has been uploaded under PwD sector.
  - (c) S.No. 4 Additional Agenda (1): Comments from MoH&FW on six revised files of Healthcare SSC: NSQC was apprised that comments of Ministry of Health &Family Welfare (MHoHFW) on the six revised Qualifications have been received and there were 14 amendments to qualifications suggested, which Healthcare Sector Skill Council need to incorporate in the Qualifications before putting upto NSQC for consideration of approval. NSQC took a note of the matter and directed to share the same with the concerned Sector Skill Council for incorporating it in totality and resubmit the Files in next NSQC for approval.
  - (d) <u>S.No. 4 Additional Agenda (2): 14 (In-Principle Approved) Qualification Files of DGT:</u> Col Santosh, Director, NCVET informed the committee that desk audit, stakeholder consultation and scrutiny of 14 Qualification fileshave been completed and being presented before the Committee for according approval.

# AGENDA ITEM 3: SUBMISSION OF QUALIFICATIONS FOR NSQF ALIGNMENT

- 6. Director informed the Committee that a total of 11 Qualifications (7 new and 4 revised) have been received from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2020 to 31<sup>st</sup> October 2020. They have been subjected to the Desk Scrutiny and stakeholders consultation and were being presented for consideration in the 4<sup>th</sup>NSQC. A brief account of all qualifications being considered for NSQF alignment were presented before the Committee members.
- 7. A consolidated statement of approval status of Qualifications considered in the 4<sup>th</sup>meeting of NSQC is placed at Annexure III(A) and the qualification wise status is at Annexure III(B). Sector-wise/Submitting Body wise discussions and decisions taken are given in succeeding paras.

#### **Qualifications Submitted By Central Ministries**

8. <u>Footwear Design and Development Institute (FDDI)</u>: 4 (Four) Qualifications in the Leather Sector submitted by FDDI for 2<sup>nd</sup> revision were placed for the approval of NSQC and the same was approved without any changes.

#### Qualifications Submitted By Sector Skill Councils (SSC)

- 9. <u>Hydrocarbon SSC:</u> One (1) Qualification file of 'Stainless Steel(SS) Tubing Technician' was placed before the NSQC. Submission of less number of Industry validations by the SSC was discussed. The Committee accepted the justification by Hydrocarbon SSC. The Committee was of the view that the entry requirement should be modified due to the hazardous nature of job profile and suggested minimum entry age for the Qualification should be 17 years. The file was conditionally approved subject to the incorporation of suggested changes.
- 10. <u>Tourism and Hospitality SSC:</u> Five (5) Revised and one (1) New Qualification file were submitted before NSQC for according approval. After due deliberations on all the criteria in each Qualification, Committee conditionally approved the qualifications subject to amendments, mentioned as under, by the Submitting Body:-
  - (a) <u>Restaurant Manager:</u> The sectoral experience in the field, mentioned as under, should be added to the entry requirement of the Qualification of 'Restaurant Manager'
    - (i) Experience of 3 years after Class 12<sup>th</sup>/2 years ITI after Class 10<sup>th</sup>.
    - (ii) 10 years after Class 10<sup>th</sup>/2 years ITI after Class 8<sup>th</sup>.
  - (b) The Committee also suggested that the Level must be pegged at Level 7 instead of Level 8 based on the NSQF level descriptors and the skill sets required.
  - (c) The Committee also directed that in all the six (6) Qualification files apart from entry requirements of 10<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> or equivalent ITI (2 years of ITI after 8<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> respectively), the following changes may be added making one year ITI courses as also an eligible entry requirement:-
    - (i) One-year experience in relevant area with ITI\* (for ITI with one-year duration) after 8<sup>th</sup>, where the eligibility is Class 10<sup>th</sup>.
    - (ii) One-year experience in relevant area with ITI\* (for ITI with one-year duration) after 10<sup>th</sup>, where the eligibility is Class 12<sup>th</sup>.

#### **AGENDA 4: QUALIFICATION FILES OF DGT**

- 11. Fourteen (14) Qualification files of DGT which were accorded 'In-Principle' approval in the 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting of NSQC held on 20<sup>th</sup> November 2020 were presented before the Committee, duly scrutinized and vetted. The qualification wise details are given as under: -
  - (a). <u>Three (3) Qualification Files of CTS</u>: One (1) Qualification File of IT-ITes and Two (2) Qualifications of Logistics sector were placed for the approval of NSQC and they were accorded approval without any changes.
  - (b). <u>Four (4) Qualification Files of CITS</u>: One (1) Qualification each from Media & Entertainment, Apparel, Paint & Technology and IT-ITes under CITS (Crafts Instructor training scheme of DGT) were presented before the NSQC. Details are as under:-
    - (i) 'Computer Aided Embroidery & Designing' of Apparel sector, 'Information Technology' of IT-Ites sector and 'Multimedia, Animation & Special Effects' of Media & Entertainment sector were approved.
    - (ii) Qualification of 'Painting Technology' of same sector was conditionally approved subject to incorporating changes as suggested by the stakeholders and submission of revised file.
  - (c) <u>Seven (7) Qualification Files of STC:</u> One (1) Qualification file of Media & Entertainment, Two(2) Qualifications of Strategic Management, Three(3) Qualifications of Beauty & Wellness and One(1) Qualification file of Office Administration and Facility Management Sector under STC were presented before the NSQC for according approval. The details are mentioned as under:-
    - (i) <u>Media & Entertainment Sector</u>: The Qualification file in respect of 2D Animator was not approved. The Committee suggested revising the same and resubmit for approval in next NSQC.
    - (ii) <u>Strategic Management Sector:</u> The Qualification files in respect of 'CNC Machinist 3-Axis' and 'Advanced CNC Machinist 5-Axis' were approved.
    - (iii) Beauty & Wellness Sector: Qualification files in respect of 'Professional Make-up Artist & Hair Stylist', 'Senior Nail Technician' and 'Senior Spa Therapist' were granted conditional approval subject to amendment of the progression path in all the three (3) files. Qualification file in respect of 'Senior Spa Therapist' was also accorded conditional approval subject to removal of the occupation of 'Sports Masseur', for which DGT may come back separately after taking comments of Sports Ministry. DGT was requested to review entry requirements of qualification file 'Senior Nail Technician' and similar courses run by other Awarding Bodies and revise and resubmit the same for NSQF alignment.
    - (iv) <u>Administration and Facility Management sector</u>: Qualification files in respect of 'Human Resource Executive' were accorded conditional approval subject to reconsideration of amendment of Progression path.

# 12. Approval of Qualifications adopted by Skill Council for Persons with Disabilities (SCPwD)

The Committee was informed that SCPwD being a horizontal SSC identifies NSQF aligned job roles from various sectors and after checking their suitability w.r.t to the type of disabilities, adopts them for developing qualifications for PwD training. In this regard, SCPwD has adopted 25 job roles from sectors, viz, Agriculture & Allied, Apparel, Make-Ups & Home Furnishing, IT-ITES, Retail, Telecom and Tourism & Hospitality and submitted

55 Qualification Files by increasing the notional hours and changing the training methodology. NSQC took a note of the matter and approved all the Qualifications. (List placed at Annexure-III (D)).

# 13. Approval of Apprenticeship Qualification from ASDC (Automotive SSC).

Qualification named 'Vehicle Manufacturing Operations' to be run under NAPS (National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme)was submitted by ASDC in the 3<sup>rd</sup> NSQC for approval. It was directed by the Committee to send the files to PwD-SSC and DGT for scrutinizing the suitability of the qualification for serving the inclusion of gender and disabled as well as the appropriateness to be run as the Apprenticeship program under NAPS. The Qualification ,duly scrutinsed and revised was resubmitted in the 4<sup>th</sup> NSQC. The revised file was placed for approval of the NSQC and the same was approved. (The details of the files is at Annexure III (E))

#### 14. Adoption of NSQF Aligned Qualifications by WBSCT & VE & SD

The NSQC stated that it is not a body empowered to take decisions on adoption of qualifications by Awarding Bodies, and it should be brought before the appropriate authority under NCVET.

#### 15. Any other item

- (i) It was again brought out in the meeting that SSCs were facing problems with respect to getting clearance from their respective Line Ministries. Their response is either unduly delayed or most often there has been no response. It was stated by the Chairperson that it had already been decided and minuted in the last NSQC meeting regarding the policy on the same. In that meeting, NSQC was of the view that in case of regulated sectors like health or aviation, the line ministry concurrence shall remain a mandatory criterion. In all other cases a four-week time shall be given to the line Ministries to indicate their concurrence, unless otherwise communicated by Line Ministry. In such cases, the NSQC would take a decision according to the facts of the case. However, if the Line Ministry sends its comments after the decision are taken, and the comments are adverse, then the same may be brought before the next NSQC meeting for discussion.
- (ii) The Chairman also directed that henceforth invite be sent to the concerned Line Ministry from the next NSQC to make the deliberations more constructive and fruitful. The Chairman further directed that relevant extract of the MoM of the NSQC be shared with the Line Ministry for better clarity and action.
- (iii) The Chairman also instructed for the inclusion of "Experience" as a part of entry requirement in the presentation from next NSQC meeting.
- (iv) The Chairman AICTE made the following suggestions:
  - a) He suggested that DGT may examine the recruitment rules for Instructors so that candidates having a Degree in related domain, in lieu of CITS certificate, may also be eligible. DGT agreed to review the same.
  - b) He appreciated the D. Voc/B.Voc/M.Voc programs and proposed that a letter may be sent to the AICTE to consider allowing them as eligibility criteria in recruitment rules of faculty positions in Engineering Colleges and Polytechnics. Chairman, NCVET welcomed the suggestion and directed that a letter in the context be written from Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE) to AICTE

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.


