

MINUTES OF THE 22nd MEETING OF NATIONAL SKILLS QUALIFICATIONS COMMITTEE (NSQC) HELD ON 25th AUGUST 2022

1. The **22nd meeting** of the National Skills Qualifications Committee (NSQC) under the National Council of Vocational Education and Training (NCVET) was held on 25th August 2022, through Videoconferencing, under the Chairpersonship of Dr. Nirmaljeet Singh Kalsi, Chairperson, NCVET. The list of participants is at **Annexure- I**.
2. The decisions taken by the Committee, w.r.t agenda items, in the meeting are given in the succeeding paras.

AGENDA ITEM 01: CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF THE 21ST MEETING OF NSQC HELD ON 28TH JULY 2022

3. The Committee **confirmed** the minutes of the 21st meeting of NSQC held on 28th July 2022.

AGENDA ITEM 02: ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON DECISIONS TAKEN IN THE 21ST MEETING OF NSQC

4. The Committee was given a detailed account of the action taken on the Minutes of the 21st NSQC meeting. The committee took note of the action taken and approved the same. The status of compliance is at **Annexure II**.
5. The Chairperson, NSQC expressed his concern over **non-adherence** to the laid down timelines regarding the submission of monitoring data related to training centres and the number of trainings undertaken in the NSQF aligned and approved qualifications. He further directed the NCVET to issue a notice to all concerned Awarding Bodies who have not submitted their report for Quarter ending June 2022 which was due by 16th August 2022. He further reiterated to all the Awarding Bodies that they must adhere to the timeline given for submission of the report hereafter.

AGENDA ITEM 03: REALIGNMENT & RATIONALISATION OF 150 DGT QUALIFICATIONS (CTS)

6. The Committee was informed that the DGT has restructured their 150 qualifications (CTS) and submitted to the NCVET with a written commitment to comply and abide by the guidelines outlined on restructuring of the DGT qualifications as per the Minutes of the 16th NSQC Meeting. Subsequently, all these 150 DGT qualifications have been **deemed approved 'On File'** and Qualification code (NQR Code) has been allotted with the following provisions:



- a) In case of any change to the extent of 20% in the NOSs mapped to the existing NOSs, the DGT may go ahead with the same as this is as per the approved guidelines.
- b) The DGT shall complete the mapping and conversion of remaining Learning Outcomes into NOSs and intimate to NCVET accordingly.
- c) Where LOs cannot be mapped to existing NOSs, new NOSs be developed by DGT for such LOs & model curriculum for the new NOSs be also developed in a time bound manner as per the priority of their teaching schedule in the upcoming session and intimate to the NCVET for uploading the same on NQR.

7. The Committee **ratified** the above provisions and directed the DGT to speed up mapping their qualifications to the relevant National Occupational Standards (NOSs).

AGENDA ITEM 04: SUBMISSION OF QUALIFICATIONS FOR NSQF ALIGNMENT

8. The Committee was given an account of 104 qualifications received till 30th June 2022 for NSQF alignment and approval. Of these 104 qualifications, 84 qualifications (20 New and 64 Revised) were considered for placing in the 22nd NSQC Meeting. The remaining qualifications could not be considered due to non-submission of complete documents. The decision of the committee on the 84 qualifications is given in succeeding paras. The summary of the qualifications is at **Annexure III**.

Awarding Bodies

9. **INDIAN ARMY (Directorate General of Signals):** The representatives of the Indian army presented **seven (07) new qualifications which were primarily developed for Indian Army 'Agniveers' going to be inducted shortly**. All the seven (07) qualifications were **accorded approval**. The details are attached at **Annexure IV**.




11. **RSA, Ministry of Textiles:** 14 revised qualifications were submitted for NSQF alignment and approval (The details are attached at **Annexure IV**). The Committee **approved all the 14 qualifications with minor changes** in the nomenclature and notional hours of below mentioned four (04) qualifications which were **agreed to by the RSA**. The details of the changes incorporated as per the decision of NSQC is as under:

12. **ASAP, KERALA:** Three (03) qualifications (01 new and 02 revised) were presented before the Committee. **Two qualifications** (01 new and 01 revised) were **approved** while **one qualification (Child Health Assistant)** was given **approval for 06 months only** owing to low training numbers. The awarding body was advised to submit the requisite training numbers within the stipulated **time period of 6 months and then only the qualification shall be considered for regular validity of 3 years as per the policy**. 15. **RUBBER SCC (RCPSDC):** Eight (08) revised qualifications presented before the Committee were **approved. The details are attached at Annexure IV.**

16. **NASSCOM:** Fourteen (14) revised qualifications were presented before the Committee. The Committee observed that while all the 14 qualifications need to be revisited with respect to the entry level criteria, NSQF Level of certain qualifications also needs to be rationalised keeping in view the revised NSQF parameters. The Qualifications were approved subject to NASSCOM revising and rationalising the qualifications as per the observations of NSQC. **The details are attached at Annexure IV.**

17. **LOGISTICS SSC:** Three (03) new qualifications and eight (08) revised qualifications presented before the Committee were **approved (the details are attached at Annexure IV)** with following suggested changes which were agreed to by the COO of the Awarding Body:



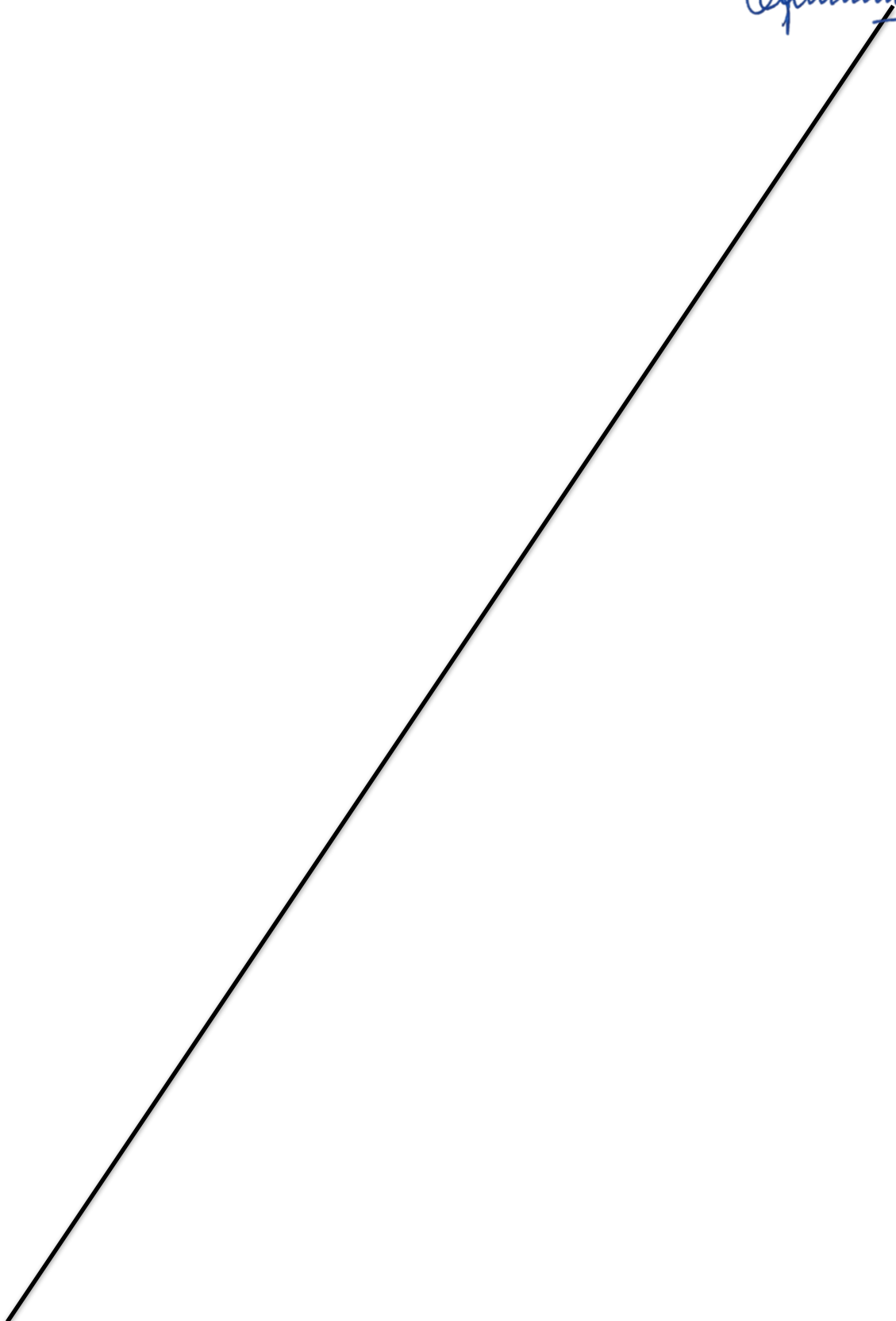


Compliance Report on Decisions Taken in the 20th NSQC Meeting

Matter pertains to	NSQC Decision	Action Taken
Monitoring & Supervision Process of Awarding Bodies	NSQC desired that all the recognized Awarding Bodies (ABs) shall share the details of the Training Centres affiliated, trainings conducted including data on assessments and placement, with respect to each NSQF aligned and approved qualification through various Govt./ fee-based schemes, on a quarterly basis for effective monitoring of the Qualification. The first report for the quarter ending June 2022 was to be submitted to NCVET by 16 August 2022.	The template for capturing data for monitoring and supervision for the quarter ending June 2022 was shared with all concerned ABs and data is being collated. Training related data has been received from 13 ABs while 33 ABs are yet to submit the requisite information.
Future Qualifications	Future qualifications approved earlier need to be re-aligned with the revised standardised NSQF norms with respect to the entry level criteria, notional hours, NSQF levels etc.	Concerned ABs are submitting the Qualifications incorporating revised notional hours in multiples of 30 and the Employability skills (ES) modules as applicable to their qualifications. Work is in progress.
Implementation of Qualifications at school levels	Committee was informed by DoSEL that school has undertaken training in certain qualifications which are at level 2.5 or 3.5. If the children desire to progress their career in such qualifications, they need to be given hand holding for undertaking OJT to enable them to complete their certification at NSQF level 3 and level 4 respectively in the requisite NSQF aligned and approved qualification. 
