

**MINUTES OF THE 34<sup>th</sup> MEETING OF NATIONAL SKILLS QUALIFICATIONS COMMITTEE  
(NSQC) HELD ON 30<sup>th</sup> November 2023**

The 34<sup>th</sup> meeting of the National Skills Qualifications Committee (NSQC) was held on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2023, through Video conferencing, under the Chairpersonship of Dr. Nirmaljeet Singh Kalsi, Chairperson, National Council of Vocational Education and Training (NCVET). The list of participants is at **Annexure- I**. The decisions taken by the Committee, w.r.t agenda items, in the meeting are given in the succeeding paras.

**1. AGENDA ITEM 01: Confirmation of the Minutes of the 33<sup>rd</sup> Meeting of NSQC held on 01<sup>st</sup> November 2023**

1.1 The Committee **confirmed the Minutes** of the 33<sup>rd</sup> meeting of the NSQC held on 01<sup>st</sup> November 2023 and approved the same.

1.2 The Committee was apprised about the following editorial corrections required in the Minutes of the 33<sup>rd</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> Meetings of NSQC respectively:

1.2.1 The Apparel, MadeUps & Home Furnishing Sector Skill Council (AMHSSC) had rationalized 12 out of total 33 qualifications. However, in the minutes of 33<sup>rd</sup> NSQC meeting (in Annexure II), the number of rationalized qualifications was inadvertently mentioned as Nil instead of 12.

1.2.2 Three Qualifications of Directorate General of Remount and Veterinary Corps were approved in the 30<sup>th</sup> NSQC meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2023. The names of the qualifications were erroneously mentioned in the minutes of 30<sup>th</sup> NSQC. The necessary corrections are given as under:

***The Committee took note of the editorial corrections in the previous Minutes of the Meeting and approved the same.***



## 2. AGENDA ITEM 02: Action taken report on the decisions taken in the 33<sup>rd</sup> Meeting of NSQC

2.1 A detailed account of the **action taken** was presented before the Committee on the Minutes of the 33<sup>rd</sup> NSQC meeting. The Committee took note of the action taken and **approved** the same and further emphasized the following:

### 2.1.1 Rationalization of Qualifications:

The Committee was presented a detailed account of the status of NSQF aligned and approved qualifications rationalized with the inclusion of ES and making NOSs multiples of 30 hours, as applicable, in order to align with the National Credit Framework (NCrF).

The Committee in its 33<sup>rd</sup> meeting had decided to provide a final extension of one month's time period for all the recognized ABs to complete the rationalization of their remaining NSQF aligned and approved qualifications latest by 30<sup>th</sup> November 2023. The Committee was apprised that out of 2790 qualifications due for rationalization, a total of 2060 qualifications have already been rationalized. The rationalization of balance 730 qualifications is under progress by the respective Awarding Bodies.

In terms of Awarding Bodies, the Committee was apprised that out of a total of 53 Awarding Bodies, whose qualifications were due for rationalization, 36 ABs have already completed rationalization of all their qualifications, 16 ABs have partially completed rationalization of qualifications and one (01) AB has not rationalized any of their qualifications. A detailed table of the same has been attached as **Annexure II**.

***The Committee took note of the pending qualifications due for rationalization and provided a final extension of two weeks' time period till 15<sup>th</sup> December 2023 to the respective Awarding Bodies who are yet to complete the rationalization of their pending qualifications, failing which the unrationalized qualifications shall be archived.***

### 2.1.2 NSQF alignment and approval of qualifications and certification of participants at various levels in the World Skills Competition

The Committee in its 33<sup>rd</sup> meeting advised all the recognized ABs (SSCs) of the concerned sectors to adopt WorldSkills standards (including the nomenclature of skills NOS, weightage), develop these qualifications in line with the requirements of National Skills Qualification Framework (NSQF), and



submit the same for NSQC approval by 18 November 2023. Further, the Committee also advised the concerned ABs to submit combined ToT and ToA qualifications of the six sectors owing to the peculiarities of training and assessment of the participants for preparing them in run-up to the World skills event.

The Committee was given a status update regarding the concerned Awarding Bodies who have so far submitted their qualifications for the World Skills Competition. Out of 19 ABs who were to submit their qualifications for NSQF alignment and approval, only 13 have submitted their qualifications and the remaining 06 ABs are yet to submit their qualifications. The Status of receipt qualifications from the concerned ABs for World Skills Competition is given as follows:

***The Committee took note of the status update and reiterated that all the concerned ABs are required to promptly submit their qualifications developed for the participants of World Skills Competition along with the***



**combined ToT & ToA qualifications for NSQC approval before the forthcoming 35<sup>th</sup> Meeting of NSQC.**

**2.1.3 Status of Provisioning a Dashboard for NCVET on SID and free registration of recognized Awarding Bodies and Assessment Agencies on SID**

The Committee in its 32nd meeting had asked NSDC to create and operationalize a separate section for NCVET on the dashboard of SID portal within four weeks i.e before the 33<sup>rd</sup> NSQC meeting. Accordingly, in the 33<sup>rd</sup> meeting of NSQC, the Committee was apprised about the meeting conducted with NSDC in which the process flow designing for onboarding of Awarding Bodies has already been worked out. However, NSDC has so far not provided any timelines by which a separate section for NCVET on the dashboard of SID portal will be ready for demonstration.

***The Committee took note of the current status and directed NSDC to complete the process of developing a separate section for NCVET on the dashboard of SID portal on urgent basis.***

**3. AGENDA ITEM 03: Revision in the Tool Kit List of 03 and 35 NSQF Aligned and approved CTS Qualifications of DGT and Logistics Sector Skill Council (LSC) respectively**

**3.1** The Committee was apprised that three qualifications of DGT namely "*IoT Technician (Smart Agriculture), IoT Technician (Smart City) and IoT Technician (Smart healthcare)*" were approved in the 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting of NSQC held on 25<sup>th</sup> August 2022 and were uploaded on NQR Website. The Committee was further apprised that a Trade Committee Meeting was held on 16<sup>th</sup> March 2023 at NSTI (W) Bengaluru for revision of Tool Kit List with respect to the above-mentioned CTS Qualifications. Accordingly in line with the recommendations of the Trade Committee, DGT has revised the Tool Kit Lists of the three qualifications without any other changes in the NSQF parameters and re-submitted the qualifications for approval.

***The Committee directed DGT to conduct a thorough review of the submitted Toolkit as certain tools mentioned in the revised toolkit need to be merged/ combined as per the latest technological interventions.***

**3.2** In addition, the Committee was further apprised that Logistics Sector Skill Council has also submitted 35 NSQC approved active qualifications for addition of new tools and equipment list in the qualifications. These qualifications incorporate additional software tools such as *Warehouse Management System (WMS), Transportation Management*



System (TMS) & Logistics Learning Management System (LLMS). The Committee was apprised that there is no change in the notional hours, levels, minimum entry criteria and the NOSs of the qualifications.

**The Committee took note of the revision in the tool kit submitted by Logistics Sector Skill Council and approved the same.**

**4. AGENDA ITEM 04: Adoption of NSQF aligned and approved Qualifications by various Defence Awarding Bodies.**

**4.1** The Committee was apprised that Headquarters, Army Training Command (ARTRAC) vide letter dated 20th November 2023, has shared a list of following 32 Qualifications, which are proposed for adoption by 15 Directorates of Indian Army (Awarding Bodies). The summary of the qualifications being adopted by various defense ABs is given below:

**The Committee took note of the same and ratified the adoption of qualifications being adopted by various Defence ABs.**

**5. AGENDA ITEM 05: NSQF alignment and approval of qualifications submitted by Awarding Bodies**

**5.1** The Committee was apprised that a total of 119 (117 New and 02 Revised) qualifications, 12 NOSs and 05 Micro-Credentials have been received at NCVET as on 30th September 2023. Out of which, a total of 105 (103 New and 02 Revised) qualifications, 12 NOSs and 05 MCs have been considered for placing in this NSQC. The decision of the Committee on all the considered qualifications, NOSs and MCs is given in succeeding paras. The detailed status of approval and decision of the Committee is placed at **Annexure III**.

**5.2 NSQF alignment and approval of qualifications submitted by Awarding Bodies (Central Ministries/State Bodies/SSCs/Other Govt & Pvt Bodies)**

**5.2.1 Directorate General of Training (DGT):** Two (02) new qualifications were presented before the Committee and were **approved**.

**5.2.2 Domestic Workers Sector Skill Council:** Three (03) new Qualifications were presented before the Committee and Two (02) were **approved** subject to the change in the nomenclature, which were agreed upon by the AB and is given in the table below:

One (01) new qualification namely "House Manager" was **not approved**.

**The Committee further highlighted that, for qualification namely "House Manager" presented at NSQF Level 5, the term "Manager" cannot be**



**included in the nomenclature of the qualification without adding relevant prior experience in the entry criteria. The qualification was not approved.**

**5.2.3 Handicrafts Sector Skill Council:** One (01) revised qualification was presented before the Committee and was **approved** subject to the following changes in the entry criteria, which was agreed upon by the AB:

**5.2.4 Logistics Sector Skill Council:** Three (03) new Qualifications were presented before the Committee. Out of which, two (02) qualifications were **approved** and one (01) qualification namely “*Rail Logistics Coordinator*” was **approved** subject to the following changes in the nomenclature, which was agreed upon by the AB:

**5.2.5 Automotive Skill Development Council (ASDC):** Four (04) new Qualifications were presented before the Committee. Out of which, 03 OEM based qualifications of Hero Motor Corps brought by ASDC namely “*Machining and Assemble Technician*”, “*Fabrication and Service Technician*”, and “*Manufacturing and Mechatronics Lead*” were **approved**.

***The Committee recommended all the other Awarding Bodies also to venture into bringing OEM based qualifications for NSQF alignment and approval.***

One (01) qualification namely “*Front Line Production Resource (NAPS)*” was **conditionally approved subject to the compliance with the NAPS Guidelines which will be issued by NCVET.**

**5.2.6 Hydrocarbon Sector Skill Council:** Seven (07) new qualifications were presented before the Committee and three (03) qualifications were **approved**.

Four (04) qualifications namely “*Green Hydrogen Assistant Plant Supervisor*”, “*Green Hydrogen Plant Supervisor*”, “*Green Hydrogen Storage Assistant Technician*” and “*Assistant Lab Technician – Green Hydrogen*” were **conditionally approved** subject to the addition of relevant experience in the entry criteria requirements, which were agreed upon by the AB.

Further, for the qualification “*Assistant Lab Technician – Green Hydrogen,*” Committee directed to add science subjects as a part of entry criteria.

**5.2.7 Skill Council for Person’s with Disability:** Twenty-Six (26) new qualifications were presented before the Committee and were **approved**

**5.2.8 Centurion University of Technology and Management (CUTM):** Two (02) new Qualifications were presented before the Committee and were **approved**

**5.2.9 Nettur Technical Training Foundation (NTTF):** Nine (09) Qualifications were presented before the Committee and were **approved**.

### **5.3 NSQF alignment and approval of NOSs submitted by Awarding Bodies (Central Ministries/State Bodies/SSCs/Other Govt & Pvt Bodies)**

**5.3.1 NASSCOM (IT-ITES SSC):** Ten (10) new NOSs were presented before the Committee and were **conditionally approved** subject to the following conditions:

- a) Submission of validations from School Boards and Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) where these NOSs may be implemented.



- b) NASSCOM (IT-ITES SSC) to replace/ embed its existing NOSs in the currently active qualifications with the newly developed NOSs, wherever applicable.

The Committee recommended a change in the NSQF level of two NOSs namely “Concepts of Computer Vision” and “Concepts of Natural Language processing” which is given as follows:

**Further, the Committee gave the following decisions:**

- a) **NASSCOM (IT-ITES SSC) to provide realistic images to represent the qualifications on the NQR portal to make it aspirational and attractive to the learners.**
- b) **Additionally, the Committee recommended all the ABs to avoid the practice of disintegrating an approved qualification into separate NOSs and further submitting the same as standalone NOSs for approval, resulting in a redundant effort.**

**5.3.2 Textiles Sector Skill Council:** Two (02) new NOSs were presented before the Committee and were **approved**.

**5.4 NSQF alignment and approval of Micro Credentials submitted by Awarding Bodies (Central Ministries/State Bodies/SSCs/Other Govt & Pvt Bodies)**

**5.4.1 Domestic Workers Sector Skill Council:** Two (02) Micro Credentials were presented before the Committee and were **approved**.

**5.4.2 Hydrocarbon Sector Skill Council:** One (01) Micro Credentials were presented before the Committee and was **approved**.

**5.5 NSQF alignment and approval of Qualifications submitted by Indian Defence Forces.**

**5.5.1 Indian Air Force:** Twenty-Five (25) Qualifications (24 new and 01 revised) were presented before the Committee and twenty-three were **approved**. Two (02) new qualifications namely “Advanced Aircraft Electrical and Electronics Technician” and “Senior Aircraft Electrical and Electronics

*Technician*” were not approved and it was decided that further deliberation may be done on the same.

- 5.5.2 Directorate General of Armoured Corps:** Three (03) qualifications were presented before the Committee and were **approved**. The Committee suggested a change in the nomenclature of one qualification namely “Assistant Manager Radio Communication” which is given as below:

- 5.5.3 Army Air Defence:** Two (02) new Qualifications were presented before the Committee and were **approved**.
- 5.5.4 Corps of Engineers:** Eleven (11) new Qualifications were presented before the Committee and were **approved**.
- 5.5.5 Directorate General of Electronics and Mechanical Engineering (EME):** Six (06) new Qualifications were presented before the Committee and were **approved**.
- 5.5.6 Directorate General Remount Veterinary Services:** One (01) new Qualification was presented before the Committee and was **approved**.

## 6. AGENDA ITEM 06: Detailed Model Curriculum and Content for the Qualifications to be offered in PMKVY 4.0

- 6.1** The Committee was apprised that in the 24<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> meetings of NSQC held on 17<sup>th</sup> November 2022 and 29<sup>th</sup> March 2023 respectively, the Committee had accorded approval to the 715 qualifications to be offered in PMKVY 4.0 including future qualifications.
- 6.2** The Committee was further apprised that a meeting was held on 21<sup>st</sup> November 2023 under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary, MSDE, in which it was discussed that the development of comprehensive handbooks has not been undertaken for a large number of PMKVY 4.0 qualifications, which is impeding the successful implementation of these qualifications.
- 6.3** The Committee was informed that out of a total of 715 NSQF aligned and approved PMKVY 4.0 qualifications, the trainee handbooks are not available for 372 qualifications and Trainer’s Handbooks are not available for 516 qualifications. With regard to the 89 Future qualifications, the Trainee/ Trainer’s handbooks are not available for 48 future qualifications.



**The Committee highlighted that the unavailability of Trainee's Handbook and Trainer's Handbook for PMKVY 4.0 qualifications is a matter of concern and needs to be addressed on an urgent basis. The Committee directed NSDC to provide a detailed list of all the Awarding Bodies who have not developed comprehensive handbooks for Trainees and Trainer's.**

**The Committee also mandated that for all types of qualifications approved by NSQC, the concerned awarding bodies shall provide a written confirmation signed by the competent authority affirming the development of the content within 3 months (90 days) from the qualification approval date, failing which the qualifications shall be deactivated/ archived.**

**7. AGENDA ITEM 07: PM Vishwakarma (Phase 2.0- Advanced Module of 120 Hours)- Development of Qualifications (Upskilling NOSs)**

**7.1** The Committee was given a brief account of the PM Vishwakarma Scheme launched by the Hon'ble PM on 17th September 2023. In this regard, the Committee was apprised about the decisions taken in the 31st NSQC meeting and the progress made so far:

- a) Approval of 28 qualifications (Upskilling NOSs) in 18 identified trades to be imparted during Phase 1.0 under Basic module of the PM Vishwakarma Scheme
- b) Creation of a separate section on NQR for PM Vishwakarma Scheme Qualifications and uploading of all qualifications under Basic module of 40 hours, including the Model Curriculum, on the NQR portal
- c) Development of learning material/ content for all qualifications under Basic module in the form of handbooks in English language by NSDC

**7.2** The Committee was apprised about the structure of the Advanced module of 120 hours to be imparted under PM Vishwakarma Scheme 2.0 has been conceptualized in the following manner:

**The Committee gave the following decisions with regard to the PM Vishwakarma qualifications:**

- a) **The respective Awarding Bodies to submit their advanced qualifications of 120 hours for NSQF alignment and approval by NSQC.**
- b) **NSDC to prepare and submit the learning material/ content for all approved qualifications (under the Basic Module) in Bhartiya languages to ensure enhanced learning outcomes of the training for the Vishwakarmas.**
- c) **The respective skills to be imparted under the Basic Module of 40 hours and Advanced module of 120 hours including digital skills, financial skills, marketing and outreach skills, entrepreneurship skills shall be separately approved as standalone Micro Credentials by NCVET for inclusion in Employability Skills (ES) modules and to be imparted separately in Schools, HEIs, and VETS.**

**8. AGENDA ITEM 08: Finalization of Training of Trainers (ToT) and Training of Assessors (ToA) Guidelines**

- 8.1 The Committee was apprised that the Draft Guidelines for Training of Trainers and Training of Assessors have been finalized after a detailed consultation with the stakeholders. Further, the draft guidelines were shared for public consultation and the inputs received from the stakeholders were incorporated and the guidelines will be notified shortly.

***The Committee suggested to take inputs from other stakeholders including MSDE and NSDC on the Guidelines giving them 10 days for any inputs and thereafter finalize the Guidelines. The finalized Guidelines to be notified at the earliest.***

**9. AGENDA ITEM 09: Notification of Guidelines for NSQF alignment and Creditisation of Skilling & Training Courses & Qualifications of Multinational Companies (MNCs) and Leading Industry**

- 9.1 The Committee was apprised that the Guidelines for NSQF alignment and Creditisation of Skilling & Training Courses & Qualifications of Multinational Companies (MNCs) and Leading Industry were approved by the Council in its 9th meeting held on 17th August 2023 and have been notified on 15th November 2023.
- 9.2 The Committee emphasized that the qualifications that the industry is bringing in their ecosystem can be also made available into the school and higher education ecosystem as well, along with the skill ecosystem. The Committee further added that this guideline would enable creditisation of all standardized learning.

***The Committee took note of the status of the Guidelines and appreciated the efforts of SSC-NASSCOM in the preparation of the Guidelines.***



**10. AGENDA ITEM 10: Finalization of SOPs for operationalization and implementation of National Credit Framework (NCrF) in Higher Education (HE), School Education (SE) and VETS for Public Consultations**

- 10.1** A high-level Committee constituted by the Government of India comprising of members from UGC, AICTE, NCVET, NIOS, CBSE, NCERT, Ministry of Education, DGT, and Ministry of Skill Development has been working towards finalizing a detailed SOP for operationalization and implementation of National Credit Framework (NCrF) in HE, SE and VETS.
- 10.2** The Committee was apprised that the SOPs for operationalization and implementation of National Credit Framework (NCrF) in HE, SE and VETS have been formulated and the same are being placed for public consultation.
- 10.3** The Committee emphasized that, in the SOP for the higher education institutions, it has been provided that up to 50% credits can be earned from the skill based education, which would enable substantial job opportunities in the skilling ecosystem. The Committee further mentioned that, if any higher education institutes want to run skill courses, but does not have the infrastructural, capacity or trainers/ instructors for the same, the SOP provides for a provision for collaboration with other entities of the skill ecosystem to implement the same.

***The Committee took note of the status and requested the stakeholders to provide comments on the SOPs once it is placed for public consultation***

**11. AGENDA ITEM 11: Additional Agenda with the permission of the Chair**

- 11.1** The Committee was apprised that, as a part of Heartland Tripura Project, NIELIT has developed 11 new NOSs to facilitate employment and to deliver specific skill development certification, along with the state government. The Committee was further apprised that the NOSs have been developed in association with Deloitte. The decision of the committee on these NOSs are enclosed as **Annexure IV**
- 11.2** All Eleven (11) new NOSs were presented before the Committee and were approved as future skill NOSs. The Committee suggested a change in the nomenclature of two NOSs namely “Risk Control and Internal Audit” and “Professional Skills” which is given as follows:
