

**MINUTES OF THE 35th MEETING OF NATIONAL SKILLS QUALIFICATIONS
COMMITTEE (NSQC) HELD ON 31st January 2024**

The **35th meeting** of the National Skills Qualifications Committee (NSQC) was held on **31st January 2024**, through Video conferencing, under the Chairpersonship of Dr. Nirmaljeet Singh Kalsi, Chairperson, National Council of Vocational Education and Training (NCVET). The list of participants is at **Annexure- I**. The decisions taken by the Committee, w.r.t agenda items, in the meeting are given in the succeeding paras.

1. AGENDA ITEM 01: Confirmation of the Minutes of the 34th Meeting of NSQC held on 30th November 2023

1.1 The committee was apprised that the Minutes of 34th meeting of NSQC were circulated and no comments were received.

1.2 The Committee **confirmed the Minutes** of the 34th meeting of the NSQC held on **30th November 2023** and approved the same.

2. AGENDA ITEM 02: Action taken report on the decisions taken in the 34th Meeting of NSQC

2.1 A detailed account of the **action taken** was presented before the Committee on the Minutes of the 34th meeting of NSQC. The Committee took note of the action taken and **approved** the same and further emphasized the following:

2.1.1 Unavailability of Trainee's Handbook and Trainer's Handbook for PMKVY 4.0 qualifications

In the 34th meeting of NSQC, the Committee highlighted that the unavailability of Trainee's Handbook and Trainer's Handbook for PMKVY 4.0 qualifications is a matter of concern and needs to be addressed on an urgent basis. The Committee directed NSDC to provide a detailed list of all the Awarding Bodies who have not developed comprehensive handbooks for Trainees and Trainer's. In view of the same, the Committee was apprised about the current status regarding the submission of Trainee's and Trainer's handbook, in which only 12 SSCs have so far submitted the required details.

The Committee took note of the status and directed the remaining SSCs to expedite the submission of Trainee's Handbooks and



Trainer's Handbooks for every PMKVY 4.0 qualifications before the the upcoming 36th meeting of NSQC, *without which, the implementation of PMKVY qualifications by the SSCs would not be possible.*

2.1.2 Finalization of SOPs for operationalization and implementation of National Credit Framework (NCrF) in Higher Education (HE), School Education (SE) and VETS for Public Consultations

The Committee was apprised that the SOPs for operationalization and implementation of National Credit Framework (NCrF) in Higher Education (HE), School Education (SE) and VETS were placed for public consultation on the NCVET's website dated 28.12.2023. The Committee was apprised that the final SOPs will be notified once the analysis and incorporation of comments is completed.

The Committee took note of the status update and directed to expedite the notification of the SOPs on an urgent basis. The committee also highlighted that the formulated SOPs will enable seamless integration of Vocational Education, Training & Skilling ecosystem (VETS) in school education, higher and technical education.

2.1.3 Status of NSQF aligned and approved qualifications rationalized with the inclusion of Employability Skills (ES) and making NOSs multiples of 30 hours, as applicable, in order to align with the National Credit Framework (NCrF).

The Committee was presented a detailed account of the status of NSQF aligned and approved qualifications rationalized with the inclusion of ES and making Notional Hours of NOSs and the qualifications into multiples of 30s, as applicable, in order to align with the National Credit Framework (NCrF). The Committee was apprised that out of a total of 53 Awarding Bodies, whose qualifications were due for rationalization, 34 ABs have already completed rationalization of all their qualifications, 18 ABs have partially completed rationalization of qualifications and one (01) AB namely National Academy of RUDSETI has not initiated the rationalization process for their qualifications. A detailed table of the same has been attached as **Annexure II.**



The committee was also informed that there is a lack of clarity in the skilling ecosystem regarding the difference between revised and rationalized qualifications. There have been certain instances in which the Awarding Bodies have submitted qualifications as rationalized qualifications in which major changes have been carried out in the core NOSs of the qualifications.

The Committee took note of the current status and reiterated that rationalization of qualifications refers to the process of aligning qualifications as per the provisions of National Credit Framework (NCrF) with the inclusion of Employability Skills and converting NOSs in multiples of 30 hours, as applicable, without amending the core NOSs of the qualification.

Any changes over and above these will result in a revised qualification which shall be brought before the NSQC for NSQF alignment and approval.

The committee directed all the ABs to expedite and complete the rationalization of their pending qualifications.

Further, the Committee instructed to conduct a meeting with National Academy of RUDSETI regarding the rationalization of their qualifications.

2.1.4 PM Vishwakarma (Phase 2.0- Advanced Module of 120 Hours)- Development of Qualifications (Upskilling NOSs)

The Committee in its 34th Meeting directed the respective Awarding Bodies to submit their advanced qualifications of 120 hours for NSQF alignment and approval by NSQC. Accordingly, the committee was apprised that out of 10 Awarding Bodies (ABs) whose advanced qualifications were due for submission, eight ABs have submitted the advance qualifications and balance two ABs namely Construction Skill Development Council of India and Capital Goods & Strategic Skill Council are yet to submit the same.

The Committee took note of the status and directed the remaining two ABs namely Construction Skill Development



Council of India and Capital Goods & Strategic Skill Council to expedite the submission of their Advanced qualifications within a week from the date of 35th NSQC meeting.

3. AGENDA ITEM 03: Adoption of NSQF aligned and approved Qualifications by various Defence Awarding Bodies.

3.1 The Committee was apprised that Headquarters, Army Training Command (ARTRAC) has shared a list of following 41 Qualifications, which are proposed for adoption by 12 Directorates of Indian Army (Awarding Bodies). The summary of the qualifications being adopted by various defense ABs is given below:

The Committee took note of the same and ratified the adoption of qualifications being adopted by various Defence ABs as per table above.



4. AGENDA ITEM 04: Urgent Approval of the Qualifications submitted to NCVET for NSQF alignment and approval

- 4.1** The Committee was apprised that Central and State governments have been initiating various schemes/ skilling programs in the country with the aim of training and skilling the youth to enhance their employment prospects. The Committee was further informed that in numerous instances, the qualifications submitted for NSQF alignment and approval require early/ urgent approval to ensure immediate implementation of these schemes and skilling programs. In order to ensure timely implementation of such schemes/ programs, NCVET has a provision to expedite the approval of qualifications by according on-file approval by the competent authority after following the approval process as per NSQF norms and subsequently place the qualifications before NSQC for ratification.
- 4.2** In the above context, it was proposed to the Committee that the respective ABs submitting their qualifications for urgent approval may submit the following documents along with the complete qualification docket.
- i. Urgency and need of the qualification are to be established.
 - ii. Complete docket along with the qualification as per the NSQF.
 - iii. Qualification handbook, trainer's handbook and student's handbook.

The Committee approved the above agenda.

5 AGENDA ITEM 05: Approval of three (03) NOSs (IT -ITeS Sector) submitted by HCL Tech and One (01) upskilling Qualification (IT -ITeS) submitted by CDAC - ratification thereof.

5.1 Approval of three (03) NOSs (IT -ITeS Sector) submitted by HCL Tech

- 5.1.1** The committee was apprised that HCL Tech has been provisionally recognized as an Awarding Body (dual category) by NCVET through issuance of Letter of Intent (LoI) on 22nd December 2023. Subsequently, as a part of the process, HCL Tech has submitted 3 NOSs (Upskilling) for NSQF alignment and NSQC approval. Further, the Committee was informed that HCL Tech had submitted 03 upskilling NOSs as a part of its collaborative partnership with UPSDM and Dr. A.P.J Abdul Kalam Technical University (APJAKTU) to undertake skill development initiatives of the youth, particularly in the field of technology.



5.1.2 In view of the same, the HCL Tech had requested NCVET for NSQF alignment and approval of the NOSs on urgent basis for early rollout of the training programs. Keeping in view the urgency to commence training on the NOSs, the parameters of the NOSs were reviewed in accordance with the NSQF norms in the stakeholders’ consultation and the comments and suggestions from the subject matter experts were incorporated in the files.

5.1.3 The Committee was informed that the three NOSs have been accorded ‘on file’ approval on 19th January 2024. The details of the NOSs are given at as below:

The committee took note of the same and ratified the NSQF alignment and approval of three upskilling NOSs submitted by HCL Tech as a Dual Awarding Body.

5.2 Approval of one (01) upskilling qualification (IT -ITeS Sector) submitted by Centre for Development of Advance Computing (CDAC)

5.2.1 The Committee was apprised that Centre for Development of Advance Computing (CDAC) has been provisionally recognized as an Awarding Body (Dual Category) by NCVET. Subsequently, as a part of the process, CDAC has submitted one (01) new upskilling Qualification for NSQF alignment and approval.

5.2.2 The CDAC had requested NCVET for NSQF alignment and approval of the qualification on an urgent basis for early rollout of the training programs. Keeping in view the urgency to commence training on the NOSs, the parameters of the submitted qualification were reviewed in accordance with the NSQF norms in the stakeholders' consultation and the comments and suggestions from the subject matter experts were incorporated in the files.

5.2.3 The Committee was informed that the qualification has been accorded 'on file' approval on 14th December 2023. The details of the upskilling qualification are given below:

The committee took note of the same and ratified NSQF alignment and approval of one upskilling qualification submitted by CDAC as a Dual Awarding Body.

6 AGENDA ITEM 06: Adoption of 03 Qualifications by Logistics Sector Skills Council (LSC) from Automotive Sector Development Council (ASDC) and 01 Qualification by Skill Council for Mining Sector (SCMS) from Indian Iron & Steel Sector Skill Council (IISCC).



6.1 The Committee was apprised that Logistics Sector Skills Council (LSC) has adopted 03 NSQF aligned and approved qualifications from Automotive Sector Development Council (ASDC) with the mutual agreement of both the ABs (i.e. LSC and ASDC) without the payment of any fees. The details of the adopted qualifications are given as follows:

6.2 The Committee was further apprised that similarly the Skills Council for Mining Sector (SCMS) has adopted 01 NSQF aligned and approved qualifications from Indian Iron and Steel Sector Skill Council (IIS SSC). Both ABs (i.e. SCMS and IIS SSC) have mutually agreed for adoption of qualifications without any fees.

The committee took note of the same and ratified the adoption of the qualifications by Automotive Skill Development Council (ASDC) and Skills Council for Mining Sector (SCMS).

7 AGENDA ITEM 07: Urgent approval of three (03) Micro Credentials (Agriculture Sector) submitted by Agriculture Skill Council of India (ASCI) - Ratification thereof.

7.1 The committee was apprised that Agriculture Sector Council of India (ASCI), had submitted 03 Micro Credentials (MCs) (Upskilling) for NSQF alignment and approval to NCVET. These Upskilling MCs were submitted by ASCI as a part of its collaborative partnership with National Commodity Derivative Exchange (NCDEX) so



as train and empower students, farmers and Farmer Producer Organization (FPO) leaders in the field of Agriculture Commodity Marketing and Management.

7.2 In view of the same, the Committee was apprised that ASCI had requested NCVET for NSQF alignment and approval of the 03 Micro MCs (Upskilling) on an urgent basis. The Committee was further informed that Ministry of Finance (MoF) and Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare (MoAFW) have also requested for early rollout of the skilling programs as these shall be vital in providing employment to 10 lakh farmers.

7.3 Keeping in view the urgency to commence training on the MCs, the parameters of the MCs were reviewed in accordance with the NSQF norms in the stakeholders' consultation and the comments and suggestions from the subject matter experts were incorporated in the files.

7.4 The Committee was informed that the three MCs have been accorded 'on file' approval on 30th January 2024. The details of the MCs are given below:

The committee took note of the same and ratified three upskilling micro-credentials submitted by ASCI.

The Committee also directed that as these micro-credentials are expected to upskill students/farmers on the emerging Agri Commodities market, these should be considered under “Future Skills”.

8 AGENDA ITEM 08: Status Update on Development of Modules/ Sub-Modules of Employability Skills/ Life Skills/ Soft Skills.

8.1 The Council was apprised that NCVET has developed a flexible model of Employability Skills (ES), which encompasses Soft Skills (SS) and Life Skills (LS) in a dynamic framework. The number of the sub-modules finalized under 9 modules were initially 47 across four variants of NCrf/ NSQF Levels. However, after due deliberation, the number of the sub-modules has increased to 50. The revised list of modules/sub-modules is attached as **Annexure III**.

8.2 The Committee was informed that the curriculum of the sub modules had been developed with the support of different agencies and the first round of validation of the curriculum of all sub modules has been completed and it is proposed to place the

same on the National Qualification Register (NQR). Now the task of Further, the development of content for the identified Modules and Sub-modules has to be undertaken in a time-bound manner with the contribution of different agencies.

8.3 For the development of the content, the Committee was apprised that NCVET has already floated 3 RFPs on GeM portal under SANKALP scheme sponsored by MSDE for onboarding competent content development agencies. Further, the submission of the content by the selected content development agencies has been divided in phases. It is also proposed to form content validation committee comprising members from MSDE, NCVET, AICTE, UGC, NCERT, CBSE, NIELET, Skill University and Institutes of Repute, etc. to validate the content developed by the agencies.

8.4 *The Committee approved the above agenda and highlighted the following points:*

- i. Employability skills modules will prove to be a very useful resource for the integration of Vocational Education, Training and Skilling in school, higher, technical and vocational education levels.*
- ii. The Committee requested all the ABs to provide their inputs/ suggestions on the developed modules.*
- iii. These modules will serve as a National Resource which will be accessible free of cost and can be utilized by all the ABs / other stakeholders.*

9. AGENDA ITEM 09: Submission of Qualifications for NSQF alignment & approval.

9.1 A total of **215 (151 New and 64 Revised)** qualifications, **18 NOSs** and **11 Micro-Credentials** have been received at NCVET as on 30th November 2023 and **183 (119 New and 64 Revised)** are being considered for placing in this NSQC. The detailed status of approval and decision of the Committee is placed at Annexure IV.

9.2 The committee was apprised about the issues being faced by the ABs while integrating skill qualifications in Undergraduate/Postgraduate (UG/PG) programs and further aligning it to NCrF norms. Further, the Committee was also apprised about the ambiguity prevailing amongst the stakeholders regarding the usage of certain nomenclatures such as Technician, senior technician, manager,



supervisor etc. against the corresponding NSQF levels/ entry requirements of certain qualifications.

9.3 Accordingly, the committee issued detailed directives regarding NCrF norms including qualifications entry requirements, usage of certain nomenclatures, integrating skill qualifications with UG/ PG programs etc. The detailed deliberation and decisions of the committee on this matter is furnished on **Agenda Item 9.6.1, 10 and 11** and are applicable to the respective qualifications.

9.4 Detailed status of the Qualifications received is in succeeding paras.

9.4.1 National Institute of Electronics & Information Technology (NIELIT): One (01) new qualification was presented before the Committee and **was approved.**

9.4.2 Directorate General of Training (DGT): Three (03) new qualifications pertaining to the IT-ITeS and Automotive sectors respectively, were presented before the Committee and were **approved.**

9.4.3 National Institute of Wind Energy (NIWE): One (01) new qualification was presented before the Committee and **was approved subject to the change in the nomenclature**, which were agreed upon by the AB and is given in the table below:

9.4.4 Tamil Nadu Skill Development Corporation (TNSDC): One (01) new qualification pertaining to the logistics sector was presented before the Committee and **was approved.**

9.4.5 Additional Skill Acquisition Programme, Kerala (ASAP): One (01) new qualification pertaining to the agriculture sector was presented before the Committee and **was approved subject to increase of 1.5 years of experience in one of the entry criteria** for the qualification and which was agreed upon by the AB.

9.4.6 **Indian Jute Industries Research Association (IJIRA):** One (01) new qualification of IJIRA was presented before the Committee and **was approved.**

9.4.7 **Centurion University of Technology and Management (CUTM):**

a. **Four (04)** new qualifications of Capital Goods sector were presented before the committee and **were approved subject to the change in the nomenclature.**

10. Clarifications for the Alignment of qualifications for NSQC Approval

10.1 The committee was apprised about the issues being faced by the ABs while integrating skill qualifications in Undergraduate/Postgraduate (UG/PG) programs and further aligning it to NCrf norms. The specific issues in this regard are outlined below:

10.2 ABs tend to put the same entry criteria as for a NSQF qualification leading to a job role resulting in confusion in terms of learning outcomes after the student completes their UG/PG program.

10.3 The nomenclature remains the same as that of a job role causing difficulty in understanding the final outcome of the job role. Eg. An Executive chef job role integrated at level 6 of a UG program may not entitle the learner to become an executive chef immediately after completing their UG.

10.3.1 Integration w.r.t notional hours of the NSQF qualification.

10.3.2 Lack of understanding on how to embed certain job roles with high OJT component

The committee took note of the issues and provided the following clarifications wrt Qualifications that are being offered as part of a pursuing UG/PG program.

- i. It is clarified that the qualifications being offered as a part of any UG / PG program (Pursuing Education), should conform to the following norms:**
- ii. Only a NOS/ MC/ Foundational Skill Courses (NSQF aligned and approved) of the duration of a single subject will be allowed to be taught in the UG/ PG program. Such a NOS/MC may only be offered as a subject and may not with the nomenclature of a job role. These shall conform to the NSQF implementation guidelines.**
- iii. Only those, NSQF aligned and approved qualifications/ job roles will be allowed to be taken up as part of UG/PG under the pursuing category which can be offered as a full semester course in the form of internship program/ Project of the duration of such courses, as per the curriculum design of the UG or PG course approved by the highest academic body of the higher education institution. These job roles shall conform to the NSQF norms and provisions.**
- iv. The nomenclature of all NOSs/ MCs shall be in the nature of a subject name or a skill or a competency. It shall not be shown to be a job role which could mislead the students or the employers.**
- v. The Skill Courses which are embedded/ built in as a part of the curriculum in the Higher Education programs as per the provisions of NHEQF, the NHEQF norms shall apply.**
- vi. However, the nomenclature of such courses shall also be in the nature of a subject or a skill or a competency name. Such Qualifications shall be of level 4.5 and above.**
- vii. Similar fundamentals will also apply to all level 3.5 and level 4 courses which are being offered in class 11th and 12th.**
- viii. Further, for any qualification/jobrole at supervisory or higher level, at least a 'one or two years' of experience, depending upon the established industry practices/ norms, of the previous level as an operator or executive or associate would be mandatory. This experience is applicable while considering the employment aspect and not the training aspect. It may however, be noted that for undertaking supervisory role skill courses, the learners should have acquired the necessary skill/experience required to undertake that course.**



- ix. It may be clarified that progression on the academic access does not automatically authorize or enable a person to gain the qualification for a job role on skill axis unless the learner possesses the requisite qualification of the previous skill level or has adequate experience to perform the job role.**
- x. Normally the total number of years of academic education and relevant experience considered for entry to an NSQF level qualification has been kept at the corresponding academic NCrF level plus one year. Also, while considering the equivalence of the work experience with the skill and academic learning experience factor of 1.5 has been applied. These shall be kept mind while proposing any new qualifications.**
- xi. As the entry qualification of 12th or 10th it should be recorded as 12th equivalent (Academic) or 10th equivalent (Academic) rather than giving unnecessary and obvious options like 8th/ 10 plus NTC/ NAC/ CTS/ CITS etc as may be applicable.**
- xii. The experience, wherever mentioned, shall only be considered if it is relevant to the job role being considered. Similarly, wherever UG and PG branch of study has relevance to the specific job roles that shall also be mentioned in the qualification.**
- xiii. A separate detailed SOP for integration of Skill based courses in Education (both School and Higher Education) is being prepared and will be shared with all Awarding Bodies.**

11. Additional agenda with the permission of the Chair

11.1 On-file approval of 05 Qualifications of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change via Skill Council for Green Jobs and ratification thereof.

11.1.1 The committee was apprised that the five qualifications, which had been submitted by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) through Skill Council for Green Jobs (SCGJ), are slated for launch by the Honourable Minister of Environment, Forest and Climate Change at Indore, Madhya Pradesh on the 2nd of February 2024. This launch is scheduled to coincide with World Wetland Day. The qualifications are designed to augment the skill sets of youth actively involved in the environment, forest, and wildlife sectors. The objective is to empower them for gainful employment or to foster entrepreneurship.

11.1.2 Further, these qualifications were accorded approval on file on 30.01.2024 and the details are as below:

The committee took note of the same and ratified the Five Qualifications.

11.2 Consideration of qualifications in the NSQC meetings

11.2.1 The Committee was apprised about the submission of incomplete qualification dockets by the Awarding Bodies leading to delay in the approval of the qualifications. The Committee was further apprised that after the receipt of the qualifications at NCVET, there is a period of two (02) months required for processing of the qualifications, after which qualification are tabled before the NSQC for consideration. During this period, the qualifications are thoroughly reviewed, aligned as per the NSQF and NCrf norms, and stakeholders' consultations are conducted. Therefore, the date of submission of the qualifications is considered after the receipt of the complete qualification docket.



The Committee took note of the issues raised and directed the following:

- i. All the Awarding Bodies, as already specified in the relevant Guidelines, must submit the complete qualification docket consisting of the following:**
 - **Q-file**
 - **Model Curriculum**
 - **Industry Validations**
 - **Line Ministry concurrence**
 - **Occupational Map**
 - **Evidence of need**
 - **Summary sheet**
 - **Any other relevant document for NSQF alignment and approval of the qualification.**

The period of 60 days commences from the day of the receipt of the complete qualification docket by NCVET.

- ii. Regarding the submission of Line Ministry concurrence, the committee highlighted that a letter must be sent to the Joint Secretary or Director of the concerned ministry / government institution from the head of the Awarding Body seeking concurrence of the Qualification. A copy of the same needs to be furnished to NCVET. Once the line ministry gives the concurrence in writing, the same needs to be produced as part of the Qualification docket.**
- iii. The committee directed all the Awarding Bodies to share a detailed list of respective line ministries along with the contact details of the concerned official/ SPOC. Accordingly, a capacity building session with the line ministries may be conducted to create awareness about the VETS initiatives in the ecosystem.**

11.3 Revision of Certificate templates of NSQF aligned and approved skill Courses.

- 11.3.1** The committee was apprised that, the NSQC in its various meetings had approved certificate templates for skill competency for Short Term Trainings, National Occupational Standards, Micro-Credentials, Upskilling, Reskilling, Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL), RPL with Upskilling, National Apprenticeship Optional Trade, University, School board.



- 11.3.2 The honorable Minister of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship has directed that, 'Skill India' logo shall be prominently displayed instead of watermark in the certificate.
- 11.3.3 Additionally, the name of the assessment agency conducting the assessment for the particular qualification shall also be included in the certificate templates.

The committee took note of and approved the same.

11.4 Incorporating RPL components in Nal Jal Mitra Qualifications.

- 11.4.1 The Committee was apprised that NCVET has received a D.O. letter (D.O. No. SCH-12/08/2023-O-o PMKVY (Pt.1)/03) from the Office of Secretary, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE), GOI. As per the D.O. letter, the Government of Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu have informed MSDE that their states have substantive number of workforces trained in similar program as of the Nal Jal Mitra Program (NJMP). Therefore, they have requested to introduce "RPL assessment and upskilling modules" (in line with NCVET RPL guidelines) in NJMP for the existing trained workforce, without compromising the quality.
- 11.4.2 To meet the requirements of the States, and maintain the uniformity in the RPL assessment methodology, the Water Management and Plumbing Sector Skill Council (WMPSSC) in collaboration with Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation (DDWS) has developed a "Standard operating procedure (SOP) for RPL assessment with upskilling" for the Nal Jal Mitra qualification and submitted it for the NCVET approval. The SOP, once approved, will be implemented in the NJMP.
- 11.4.3 NCVET had done the detailed review of the SOP and approved the same subject to the inclusion of the following provisions of the NCVET RPL guidelines for the better implementation of the RPL program.
- i. The assessment shall be based on the learning outcomes, to be defined for each National Occupational Standards (NOSs)/ Performance criteria (PCs) of the concerned qualification.
 - ii. The RPL assessment may be conducted in project mode or individually. In case of assessment in project mode, the strength of trainees assessed shall be restricted to the strength of 5. In case of individual assessment, trainee shall be assessed individually.
 - iii. Assessment of the practical skills shall be based on the work experience and conducted in physical mode.



- iv. Every assessment shall be proctored and supported with digital and video evidences with geotagging, and may be subjected to audit as per the prescribed norms.

The Committee took the note of the same and ratified the decision.

11.5 Introducing a system of Re-assessment and fixing the minimum pass percentage for Skill Based Courses in VETS

11.5.1 The committee was apprised that, a letter has been received from the Director, General Education, Government of Kerala raising a query that, unlike academic programs, the concept of re-assessments (Supplementary examinations) is not there in the Vocational Education and Training landscape. Additionally, the pass percentage of various Skill courses also varies from program to programs. The Director, General Education, Government of Kerala has sought clarification in this regard.

The committee took note of the matter and directed NCVET to create a sub-committee to take decisions on the same.
