IMPORTANT EVENTS

NIELIT Organised Digital India #FutureSkills Summit at Guwahati, Assam

The National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT), a premier institution under the MeitY, Govt of India, was pivotal in organizing the ground breaking first-ever Future Skills Summit in Guwahati on February 15, 2024. The Summit witnessed the convergence of esteemed dignitaries, Industry leaders, academia, policymakers and technology enthusiasts to deliberate strategies for Catalyzing future-ready talent for India & the World.

Shri Rajeev Chandrasekhar, Hon'ble Union Minister for State for Electronics and IT, Skill Development and Entrepreneurship emphasized how India's economy has progressed significantly over the past decade, from being a 'fragile 5' to now being ranked as the world's 'top 5' economy. This important milestone, under the leadership of Hon'ble PM Narendra Modi, has unleashed a myriad of opportunities for young Indians, particularly in emerging technology sectors, where India is on the same starting line as the rest of the world, instilling a sense of



hope and optimism. He said, "It was because of the leadership of Hon'ble CM Hemanta Biswa Sarma, a semiconductor packaging plant will be established in partnership with the Assam Government and TATA Group. We will soon obtain all approvals and submit it to the cabinet for final approval. Young Indians aspiring to enter the world of semiconductors won't have to leave their state or travel to other cities anymore."



Hon'ble Minister of Education, Govt. of Assam, Dr. Ranaj Pegu said that the Government of Assam has taken many steps for the Digital Skilling of youths in Assam. He said "Projects worth Rs. 1800 crore have been implemented by the Assam Govt. to skill our youths on industry 4.0 across 77 polytechnics and ITIs. Recently an

agreement was signed with TATA and also allotted 150-acre land to establish a Semiconductor industry near Guwahati". He interacted with numerous representatives of Start-ups and academia. The summit also organized an exhibition that showcased over 30 innovative future skills, technologies, and solutions.

Discussions revolved around the impact of rapid digitization across the globe, highlighting the emergence of new opportunities for young Indians in next-generation cutting-edge technologies like AI, ML, Semiconductors, Robotics, Cyber Security, etc. These technologies open tremendous opportunities for Young Indians. A pivotal objective is to forge partnerships with industry and academic institutes nationwide, ensuring Curricula align closely with industry demands and standards. Among the key speakers of the summit were Sh. Kuntal Sensarma, Economic Adviser, MeitY, Ms. Jaya Jagadish, Head, AMD India, Shri. Ruchir Dixit, Vice President & Country Manager, Siemens EDA, Shri Lingraju Sawkar, President, Kyndryl India, Shri. Ganesh Gopalan, CEO and Co-Founder, Gnani.AI, Prof. Subhasis Chaudhuri, Director, IIT Bombay.



The summit facilitated more than 30 strategic collaborations between NIELIT and leading industry players and academia such as Intel, HCL, Microsoft, Kyndryl, IIM Raipur, IIITM Gwalior and Wipro, etc. These collaborations, which aim to bridge the gap between academia and industry, ensuring that educational programs are tailored to meet industry standards and demands, are of significant importance and will have a profound impact. In addition, four engaging panel discussions were held on key themes such as Semicon India, IndiaAI, Cyber Security & Emerging Technologies and Digital India's Talent for the

Global Workforce. Also, many Startups and firms have shown 40 Stalls. On behalf of the NIELIT fraternity, Dr. Yumnam Jayanta Singh, ED of NIELIT Guwahati, highlighted the organization's activities and delivered a vote of thanks.

The 2nd NIELIT's International Conf-on Communication, Electronics and Digital Technologies (NICEDT-2024)



The 2nd International conference organized by the NIELIT, held on 16-17th February 2024 at Guwahati, India, covered the latest research and development in Information, Electronics and Communication Technologies and allied areas along with a panel discussion on potential collaborations with International Institutes and Industries and also possible students and faculty exchange programs. The conference was graced by the presence of distinguished individuals. Sri Mridul Pachani & Dr Saurov Mahanta served as organizing Secretaries, while Dr.Yumnam Jayanta Singh, ED of NIELIT,

Guwahati delivered a welcome address on behalf of the NIELIT fraternity. The Guest of Honours included Prof. P.Handique VC, Gauhati University, Shri Dhrubajyoti Borah, ACS, Director of Technical Education, Govt. of Assam, and Chief Guest Prof. Rajeev Ahuja, Director, IIT Ropar & Guwahati. Ten thousands Certified under NCPUL

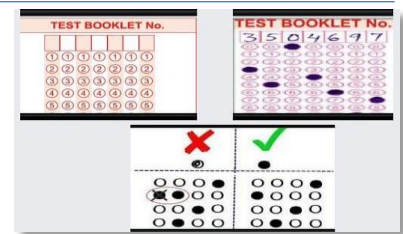


NIELIT Chandigarh certified 10,117 candidates under the NCPUL (National Council for Promotion of Urdu Language) for one-year “Certificate course in Computer Applications, Business Accounting and Multilingual DTP (CABA-MDTP)” and also registered 12,750 candidates in January under the said course. The course is designed for transformation of Urdu speakers into productive human resource and making them part of the employable technological work force in the emerging Information Technology scenario and penetration of computer

education to grass root level. In the Energy Accounting Division, paper-less and smart meter billing implemented with summarized Payment Modules of Digital Transactions made in different modes.

Conduct of Recruitment Examinations and Processing

NIELIT has been providing Recruitment/Selection solutions to various Govt. Departments (Medical Institutions, Education Department, Police Department, CDAC etc.) under Central Ministry and Govt. Departments of Punjab, Chandigarh and Haryana States. During the quarter from January to March, 2024, six major OMR-based Recruitment exams were conducted for Govt. Departments of Punjab and Chandigarh. Approximately, 80,000 candidates appeared in these exams. The latest technology is effectively used in the implementation and conduct of safe and secure examination.



The post-exam activities like preparation of various reports related to examinations like generation of merit lists and various analytical data reports were carried out within stipulated time limits with utmost satisfaction of the user departments. NIELIT is focussing on further identification of technologies in conduct and assessment of examination with involvement of all stakeholders including the organizations requesting the conduct of recruitment examination and various staff deployed for smooth conduct of exam. NIELIT Ropar has developed a Blockchain Based Certification Platform with a user-friendly front end. The certificate will be having a QR code also and it will be stored on the Blockchain. The certificates of the students can be verified by any employer from the Blockchain which is trustworthy and authentic.

INAUGURATION OF CENTRES

NIELIT Bikaner Centre Officially Inaugurated

The NIELIT Bikaner was inaugurated on February 23, 2024, by Shri Arjun Ram Meghwal Hon'ble Member of Parliament from Bikaner, Minister of Law and Justice (Independent Charge), Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs & Culture Government of India. The objective of the project is to offer diverse courses covering emerging technologies, Digital Competency, NIELIT O/A level programs, as well as summer training/internships and FDPs. The NIELIT Bikaner Centre will be housed across two prominent locations within the city: **Govt.**



Dungar College, Bikaner:

Situated on the first floor of the drawing & painting block, this facility spans approximately 3240 square



feet. It boasts of three state-of-the-art computer labs with a total capacity of 62 students, along with a spacious 35-seater classroom. Govt. Dungar College has provided this built-up space on a rent-free basis for 30 years. **Maharaja Ganga Singh (MGS)**

University Innovation Center: Located within the Innovation Centre building of MGS University, this site offers a total built-up area of around 2360 sq. ft. It features six modern classrooms capable of accommodating up to 120 students, complemented by two fully-equipped computer labs with a combined capacity of 100

students. The budget outlay of the project is Rs. 705.60 Lakh. The project sets a training target of 1999 candidates over the course of three years.

Inauguration of NIELIT Centre at Hyderabad, Telangana



NIELIT Hyderabad Centre was inaugurated by Shri G. Kishan Reddy, Hon'ble Union Minister for Tourism, Culture, and Development of North Eastern Region, on the 13th of March 2024. MeitY, Govt of India granted administrative approval for the project title "Setting up of NIELIT Centre at Hyderabad, Telangana", with a total budget outlay of Rs. 474.26 lakhs having a total training target of 2200 over a period of 03 years. The Centre is being established on a rent-free built-up space of appx. 11,000 sq. ft provided by the Telangana State Govt. in Ashoka Raghupathi Chambers, Begumpet, Hyderabad. The objective of the project is to generate quality manpower and develop skilled professionals in the area of IECT and allied, by providing world-class education & training and accreditation services

NIELIT Extension Centre Buxar Inaugurated



NIELIT Extension Centre, Buxar was inaugurated by Shri Ashwini Kumar Choubey - Hon'ble Union Minister of State, Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution and Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India on 30th January 2024, in the presence of The Director General of NIELIT Dr. Madan Mohan Tripathi. The Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) approved the project entitled "Setting up of NIELIT Extension Centre at Buxar in Bihar State" on 25th September 2019, with a total budget outlay of Rs 930.41 Lakh, out of which Rs. 917.59 Lakh has been earmarked for construction of the permanent campus, equipment & other

infrastructure for the Centre. There is a target to train approximately 1155 students over a period of 03 years in various short and long-term courses. The project was extended up to 31st March 2024.

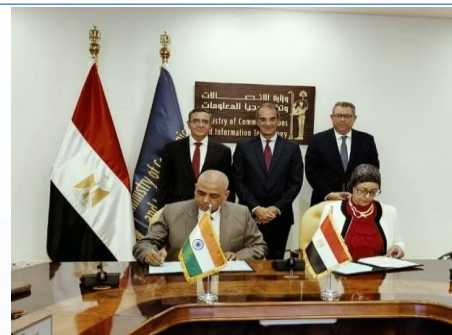
The objective of this project is to offer various courses and programs that equip students and professionals with the requisite skills in the field of Electronics and Information Technology to thrive in the digital age.

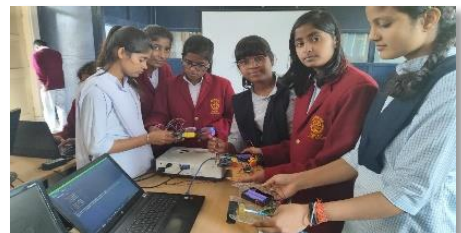

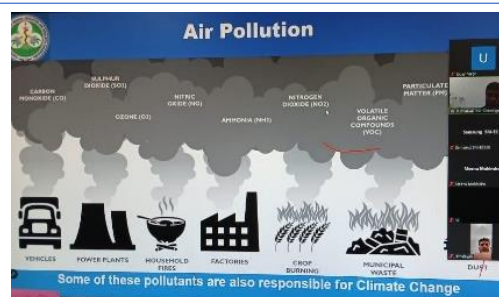

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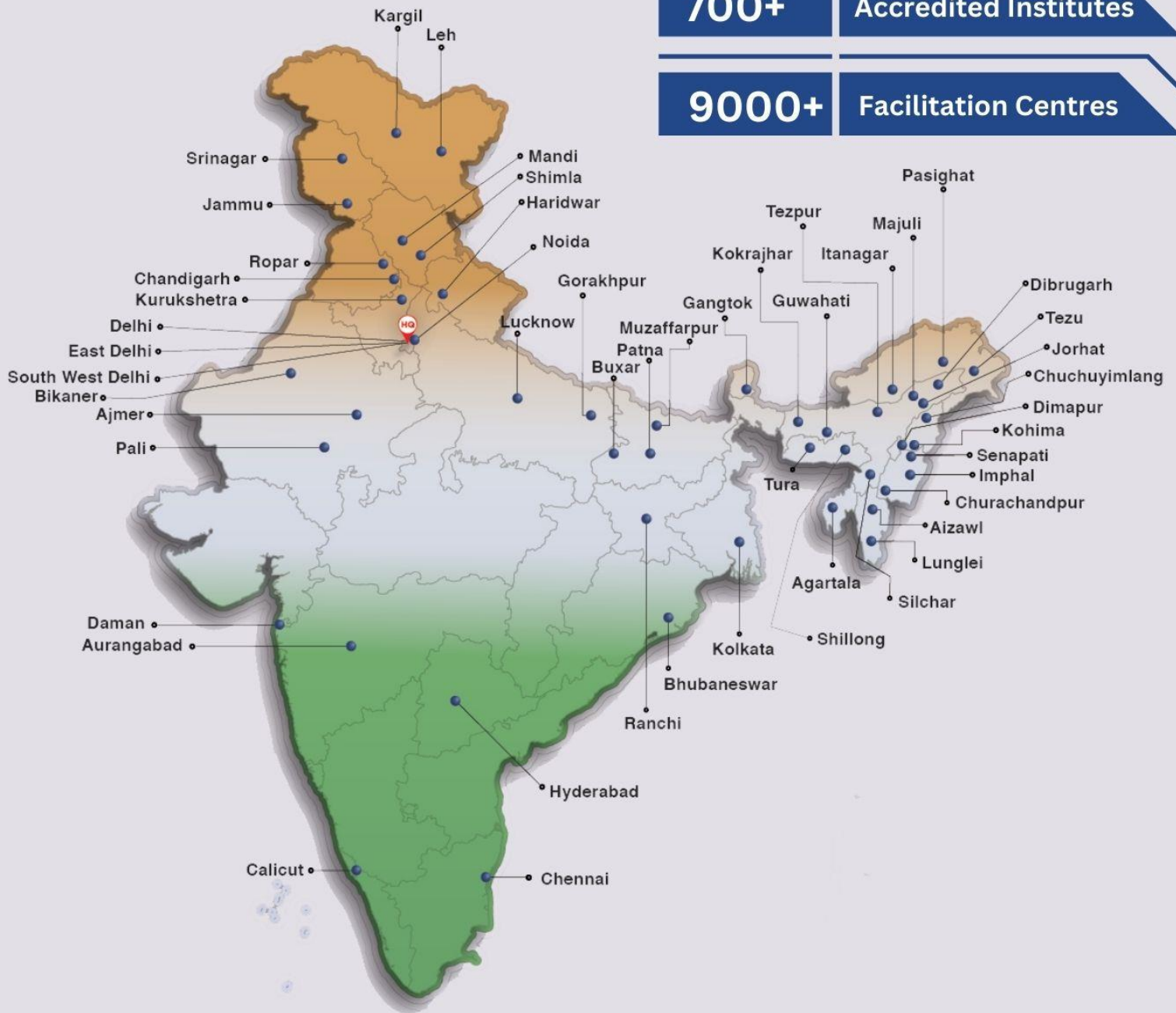
